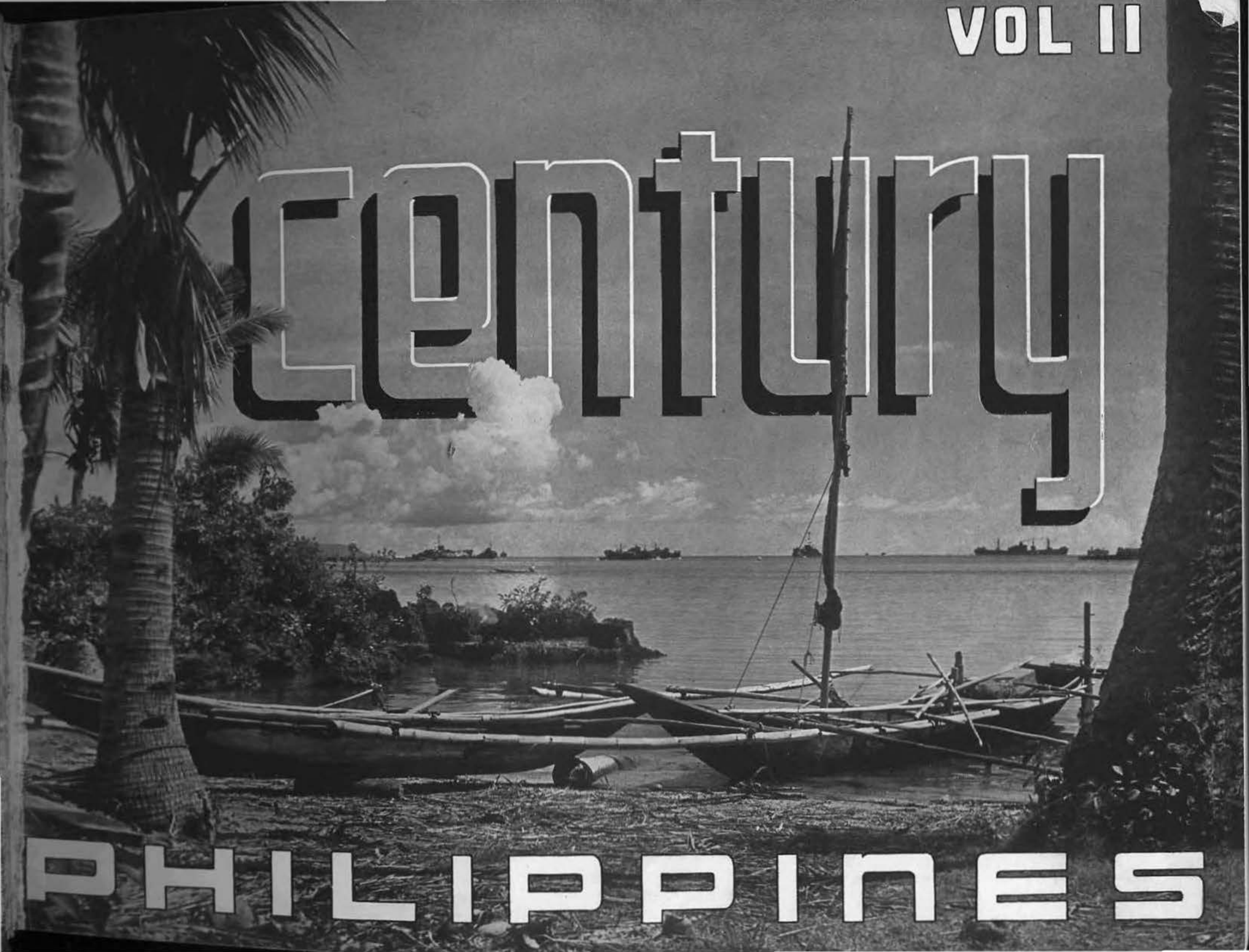

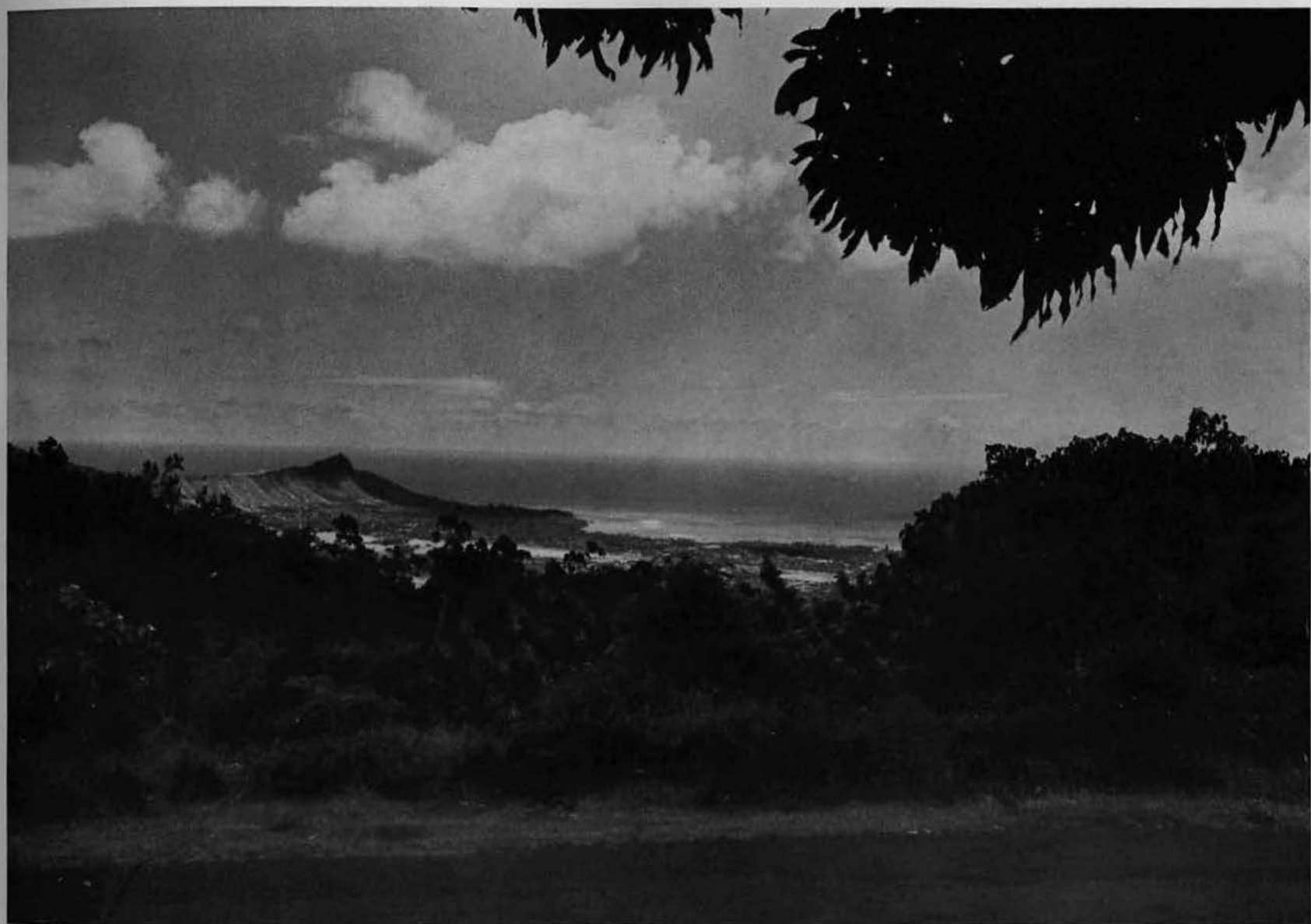
foreword
