## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Using the following template, write a letter to a sailor. You can include where you're from, what grade you're in, a picture you drew, etc. Be as creative as you want! *Make sure to thank the sailor for serving in the Navy. These men and women keep us safe thanks to the important work they do!*
2. Mail your letter to a ship. Ask your parents to look up the mailing address (FPO) for your favorite ship. Each Navy ship has a website with a contact page (usually [www.SHIPNAME.navy.mil](http://www.SHIPNAME.navy.mil)). Recently deployed ships include: *USS Reagan, USS Dwight D. Eisenhower, USS Nimitz, USS Lincoln, USS Harry S. Truman, USS Gerald R. Ford, USS Bataan, and USS Essex*. Address your letter to the Ship's Chaplain, who will deliver your letter to a homesick sailor.
