Overview: Assign students to complete the crossword puzzle of vocabulary words. The words learned in this activity were used extensively throughout the Puget Sound Navy Museum.

Grade Level: 1-4

Essential Questions: What do these key vocabulary words mean? What tools did you need to use to find the meaning of these words?

Evaluation: Teacher may collect completed worksheet as a mean of evaluation

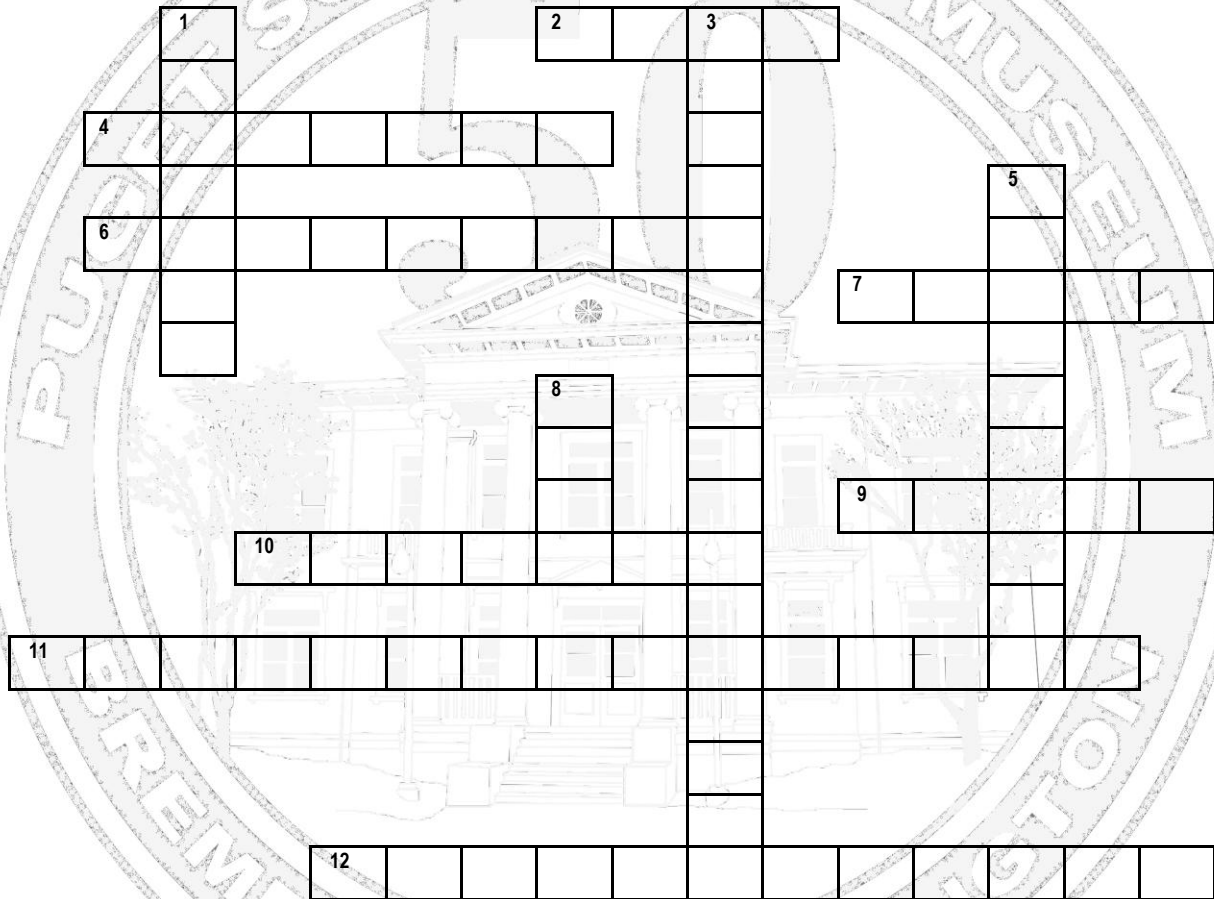

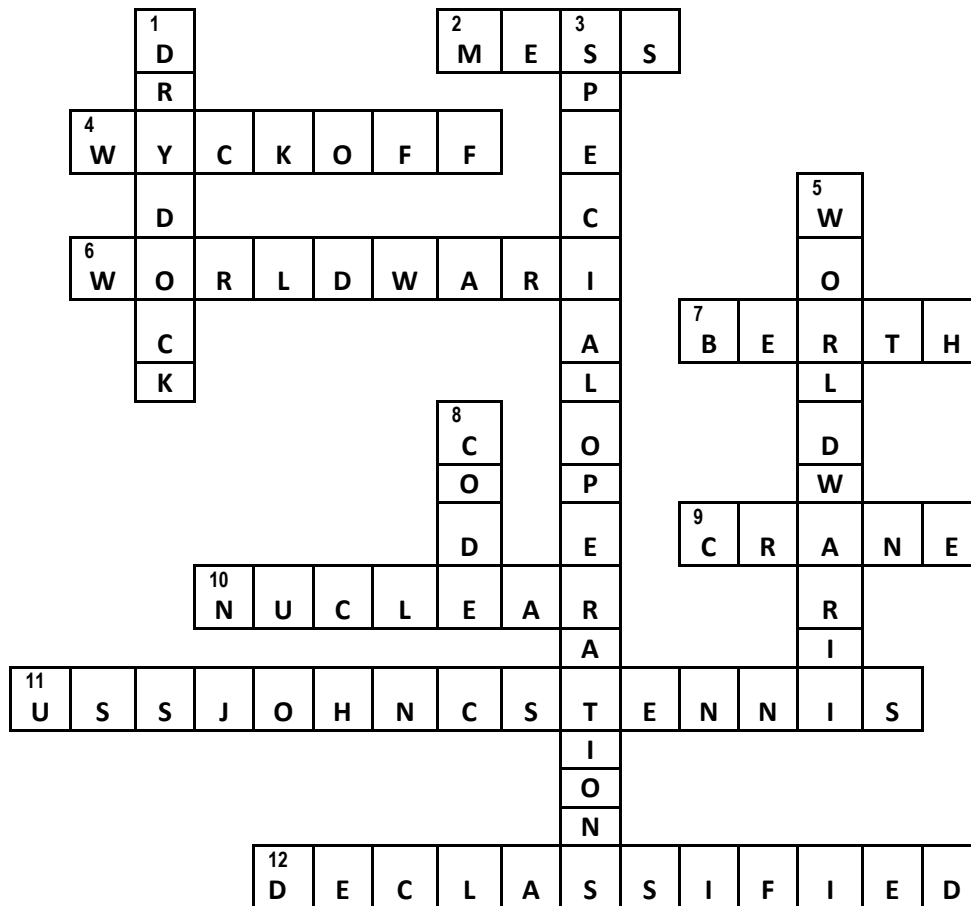
