Pre- Visit Crossword Puzzle

Overview: Assign students to complete the crossword puzzle of vocabulary words. The words learned in this activity are used extensively throughout the Puget Sound Navy Museum.

Grade Level: 1-4

Time: 15-30 min.

Essential Questions: What do these key vocabulary words mean? Can you use the context of the definition to help you figure out the word, even if you don't know it? Can any of these words mean something else?

Materials Needed: Crossword puzzle, pencil

Procedure: Assign students to complete the crossword puzzle individually or in small groups. It may be necessary to work through the activity as a class with younger students.

Evaluation: Teacher may collect completed worksheet as a means of evaluation

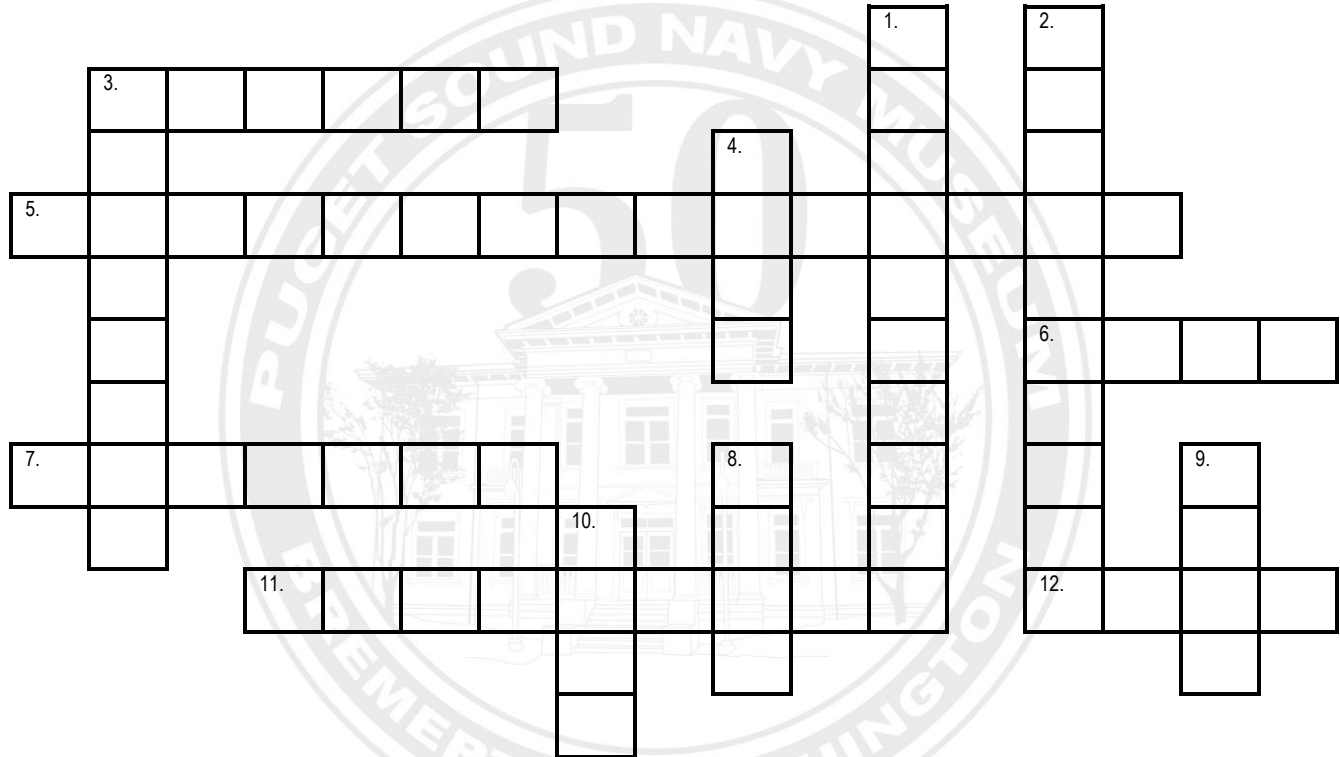

12. Places (often a pier) where ships can load, unload, and park.

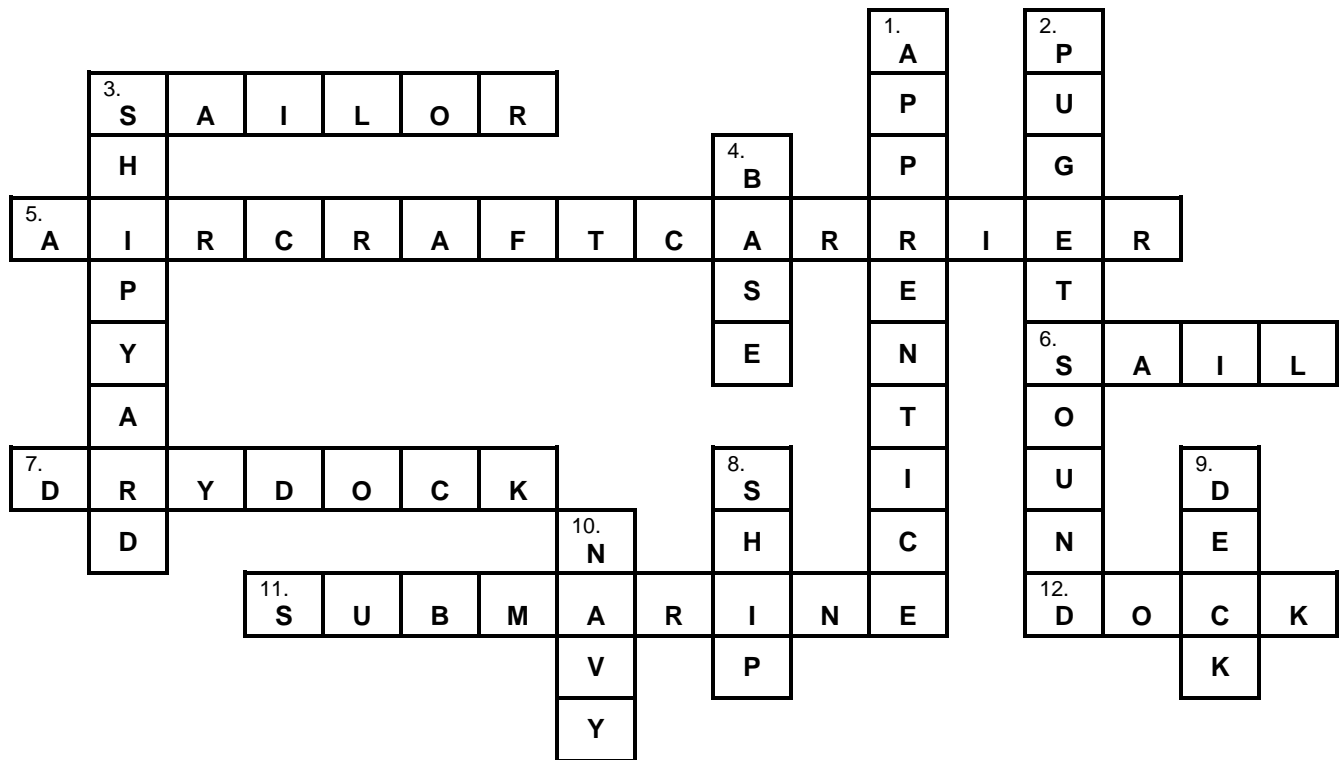
DOWN
