
MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

Subject: Phone Conversation with Captain James Holland, USN,  
COMUSNAVCENT/5<sup>th</sup> FLT N53 Related to USS COLE (DDG 67) Damage Control

1. I had requested and received permission to talk to CAPT Holland because he was aboard COLE during to timeframe of this inquiry's interest.
2. CAPT Holland arrived on board COLE inport Aden, Yemen PM 13 October 2000. He was assigned as COMFIFTHFLT's JAGMAN investigating officer for all events leading up to, but not including events subsequent to the 1118C 12 October 2000 explosion. Although he was aboard COLE and rendered advice and assistance, he did not investigate the post-explosion damage control response.
3. CAPT Holland was not able to contribute any additional information to that which we had already gathered from logs and interviews. He did offer that in his professional opinion, the crew was well led, had the situation in hand and appeared to be well trained, or words to that effect.
