SUBJECT: Weekly Bulletin for week ending December 1 1917.

- l. A number of kite balloons are being shipped to Naval Air Station, Rockaway L.I. N.Y., for comparative tests.
- 2. Partially successful dirigible tests have been made at Naval Air Station, Pensacola, Florida. At this same station two seaplanes have been equipped with radio apparatus for experimental cooperation with the U.S.Army Coast Artillery at Fort Barransas. Experiments with visual smoke signals from seaplanes are also in progress at Pensacola.
- 3. At the direction of the Secretary of the Navy, enrollment of men in civil life for U.S.N.R.F. Class 4 for 5 for flight training has been temporarily stopped.
- 4. Lieutenant E.O.McDonnell U.S.N. has been relieved as Commanding Officer, Naval Air Station, Naval Aperating Base, Hampton Roads, Virginia, by Lieutenant Commander P.N.L.Bellinger U.S.N.
- 5. Hours of flying obtained during the past week at Naval Aviation Detachments and Naval Air Stations, together with number of flights and number of seaplanes per station (exclusive of seaplanes of types considered unsuitable for flight instruction purposes.
