- Dec'42 - formed at NCTC Norfolk (Known as "CB Casualty Det. 1003")
- 16 Dec'42 - Transferred to Base Depot, FME, Norfolk.
- 17 Dec'42 - Transferred to FME San Deigo FFT 1st Marine Amphibious Corps
- 8 Jan'43 - Sailed from the U.S.
- 23 Jan'43 - Absorbed by the 19th CB(1st MarDiv).

1003 Detachment (INACTIVE)

CBD 1003

Formed in December 1942 at Norfolk, Va., Detachment 1003 was transferred to the First Marine Amphibious Corps at San Diego Dec. 17. The detachment shipped out Jan. 8, 1943 and on Jan. 23 was absorbed by the 19th Battalion at Noumea, which was then assigned to the First Marine Division.
