- 9-25-43 - Lt. Bowles is to report to his superior command as Technical Observer Conasaero. (Bupers Disp. 21 Sept'43 1337 to OinC of 1010)
- 10-22-43 - Lt. Alexander added from roster of 1 October 1943. *TEMP. DUTY - MGR FISHER*
- 5-12-44 - Officer roster checked with 1 Apr'44 report and OK - operating at Tulagi.
- 6-6-44 - Officer roster checked with 1 May'44 report - Lt. Alexander detached to Budocks. Operating at Tulagi.
- 7-4-44 - Officer roster checked with 1 Jun'44 report and OK. Operating at Tulagi.
- 7-13-44 - Lt. (jg) Attwill detached to Budocks (Budocks ltr to Bupers dtd 20 Jun'44).
- 10-31-44 - 1 Oct'44 report of Det. 1010 - No info on location. This detachment is a smoke screen unit and was ^{the} trained nucleus for the First Provisional Smoke screen Unit. On 13 Aug'44, the First Prov. Smoke Screen Unit was disbanded and this detachment became inoperative. During Sep'44, the unit has been in a rehabilitation status, and is maintaining and repairing its equipment.
- 11-4-44 - CBD 1010 inactivation approved. Wherever practicable it is suggested that all personnel that can be spared be returned to the U.S. (CNO conf. disp to Cincpac 021655 NCR 3020 dtd 2 Nov'44).

- 11-13-44 - CBD 1010 is located at Guam. (Is. Com. Sec. airmailgram to CNO 011201 NCR 14731 dtd 6 Nov'44).
- 12-8-44 - Request that all personnel of Det. 1010 that are available be returned to Parks for a training staff for smoke defense. (CNO Sec. ltr Op30-31SK:RHS over (SO) S77-1 over 01383830 dtd 28 Nov'44)
- 12-27-44 - Det. 1010 inactivated effective 15 Dec'44; personnel directed to report to Camp Parks for temporary duty. (OinC 5th Brig. ltr SNCBr/A3 over APG:ajk over Ser 1659 dtd 15 Dec'44 to OinC Det. 1010)
- 1-20-45 - Cincpacflt Sec. ltr (1st End. on CNO Sec. ltr 01383830 dtd 28 Nov'44) Ser. 0061 to Comserforpacflt dtd 5 Jan'45 - requests that all personnel of CBD 1010 that is available be returned to the U.S. for further assignment by Bupers.
- 2-1-45 - Det. 1010 personnel transferred to Parks from Guam leaving about 17 Dec'44 for temp. duty. (5th Brg. sec ltr Ser 002312 to CNO dtd 16 Jan'45)

- 9-14-44 - 1 Sep'44 report of Det. 1011 - operating at Ft. Pierce.
- 12- 1-44 - 1 Nov'44 report of Det. 1011 - operating at Ft. Pierce, Fla.
- 12-18-44 - 1 Dec'44 report of Det. 1011 - located at Ft. Pierce, Fla. Detachment was divided into 3 groups in preparation for a complete rotation of physically fit personnel.
- 1-23-45 - 1 Jan'45 report of Det. 1011 - located at Ft. Pierce, Fla. Original personnel of this detachment were transferred to CBRD Parks. CD #2564 (63 men) was rec'd on 19 Dec'44 from Parks; CD #2565 (90 men) was rec'd 26 Dec'44 from Parks.
- 3-16-45 - 1 Mar'45 report of Det. 1011 - located at Ft. Pierce, Fla.
- 4-12-45 - 1 Apr'45 report of Det. 1011 - located at NavAmphTraBase, Ft. Pierce, Fla.
- 5-15-45 - 1 May'45 report of Det. 1011 - located at Ft. Pierce, Fla. GD2675 received aboard 16 Apr'45 consisting of 50 men. GD 2676 consisting of 58 men was transferred to Davisville on 16 Apr'45.
- 6-12-45 - 1 Jun'45 report of Det 1011 - located at PhibTraBase, Ft Pierce, Fla.
- 7-11-45 - 1 Jul'45 report of Det 1011 - located at PhibTraBase, Ft. Pierce, Fla.

- 8-8-45 - 1 Aug'45 report of Det 1011 - located at PhibTraBase, Ft. Pierce, Fla. 50 men were received on board on 23 Jul'45 from Bainbridge, Md.
- 8-18-45 - 1 Sept'45 report of CBD 1011 - located at PhibTraBase, Ft. Pierce, Fla. 49 men transferred for discharge under point system.
- 10-22-45 - 1 Oct'45 report of CBD 1011 - located at PhibTraBase, Ft. Pierce, Fla. 58 men transferred for discharge under point system. 17 men rec'd from CBMU 570.
- 11-6-45 - 1 Nov.'45 report of CBD 1011 - located at PhibTraBase, Ft. Pierce, Fla. 47 men transferred for discharge under the point system. 24 men are aboard from USNATB, Ft. Pierce, Fla.
- 12-17-45 - 1 Dec'45 report of CBD 1011 - located at PhibTraBase, Ft. Pierce, Fla. 23 men transferred for discharge. 20 men rec'd during Nov.
- 1-29-46 - 1 Jan'46 report of CBD 1011 - located at PhibTraBase, Ft. Pierce, Fla. 81 men rec'd during Dec. 26 men transferred during Dec.
- 2-13-46 - All personnel transferred from CBD 1011 on 2 February 1946. Unit considered inactivated as of that date. (OinC Caretaker Force USNATB, Ft. Pierce, Fla. disp 201715 to BuPers).

CBD 1010

Formed at Port Hueneme in July 1943, CBD 1010 sailed overseas from Hueneme Aug. 22, 1943, arriving at Tulagi in September. In August 1944 the unit was moved to Guam, where it operated until it was inactivated on Dec. 15, 1945, and the personnel was transferred to Camp Parks.

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ITINERARY OF CONSTRUCTION BATTALION DETACHMENT 1010

- Jul 1943 - Formed at ABERS, Port Hueneke, Calif.
22 Aug 1943 - Departed ABERS, Port Hueneke for Tulagi.

Date of arrival at Tulagi is unknown.

Aug 1944 - Moved to Guam - date is unknown.

- 15 Dec 1944 - Inactivated at Guam this date - personnel transferred to CERD,
Camp Parks, Shoemaker, Calif. for assignment.
