- 12-29-43 - Officer roster checked with 1 Dec'43 roster and OK.
- 1-19-44 - Nov'43 report CB Det. 1015 arrived at destination 7 Nov'43.
- 2-16-44 - End-4 by BuShips on Det. 1015 monthly report for Dec'43 (endorsement dated 12 Feb'44) states that Detachment 1015 and 1016 are to be replaced shortly by general service personnel.
- 3-24-44 - Ens. Smith detached to 57th CB (Budocks ltr to Supers dated 21 Mar'44).
- 5-30-44 - From 1 Apr'44 report - 15 general service personnel reported 27 Mar'44 for duty -- are being trained to take over Det. 1015 operations.
