- 7-18-45 - Comservpac ~~encnf~~ spdltr 00265 dtd 19 June requests 2 CBDs for assignment to AK-75 and AK-77 Pontoon Assembly Ships. In accordance therewith, BuPers is requested to form and outfit CBDs 1094 and 1095 each composed of 2 off. and 35 men trained in pontoon work. These units to be ready at Hueneme on 5 and 14 August resp. (CNO sec ltr ser 00299030 dtd 17 Jul'45 to Bupers and ComWesSeaFron)
- 7-27-45 - In view of curtailment of pontoon shipments & assembly activity, recommend CBDs 1094 & 1095 be inactivated immediately. (Comwesseafron conf spdltr ser 07873 dtd 31 Aug'45 to Comservpac, Pacific Flt).
- 7-19-45 - CNO directs Camp Parks to inactivate CBDs 1094 & 1095 in accord ComWesSeaFron ~~encnf~~ ltr ser 90496 dtd 8 Sept'45. (CNO spdltr ser 636230 dtd 15 Sept'45 to Camp Parks).
- 7-26-45 - Comservpac concurs in the inactivation of CBDs 1094 & 1095. (Comservpac restr spdltr ser 4755 dtd 26 Aug'45 to Comwesseafron).
- 7-26-45 - CBD 1095 inactivated 26 Sept'45. (Camp Parks TWX 262253 Sept'45 to BuPers).

- 21 Aug 1945 - ComCinCaffren recommended inactivation of both units.
- 15 Sep 1945 - Ordered inactivated by CGO.
