C. B. Detach. 1105

- 1-11-46 - CNO approved the formation of two Material Salvage Units each to be composed of 7 off. & 10 men with two CB detachments of 3 off. & 127 men. In order to proceed with the organization of these units, CB detachments 1102, 1103, 1104 & 1105 are being activated. An allowance of 3 off. & 127 men is being authorized for each of the above units. They will report to CinC, 20th Reg. until such time as the Materials Salvage Units are ready for operation. (Comservpac ltr ser 12 dtd 3 Jan '46 to CincPoa).
- 1-21-46 - Ordered to report to CO, Material Salvage Unit #1, for duty. (Comservpac ltr ser 166 to CinC CBD 1105, dtd 1-10-46.)
- 1-28-46 - Material Salvage Unit #1 being sent to Milne Bay in Feb. to load out remaining cargo. (Comservpac, Pearl disp 190110 Jan'46 to BuPers).
- 3-7-46 - CBDet ordered to report to CO of LST 45 for transportation, quarters, messing and maintenance facilities. (MSU #1 ltr Ser 02-46 dtd 26 Feb 46 to CinC).
- 3-11-46 - CO MSU #1 (CTG 16.11) orders LST 45 to proceed to U. S. Naval Base, Milne Bay, New Guinea, on or about 23 February 1946, and to report to MSU #1 for duty. (MSU #1 ltr ser 06-46 dtd 26 February 1946).
- 1-21-46 - CBD 1105 was inactivated 31 December 1946. Personnel transferred to MSU #1.
