- 1-21-44 - Request CBMU 615 be transferred direct to ABD Hueneme. (Conf disp 191750 NCR 3710 from ABRB Hueneme to NCTC Davisville)
- 1-25-44 - Request for transfer to Hueneme disapproved. (Conf disp NR38 201355 NCR 6175 GR6 dtd 22 Sep from CNO to ABRB Hueneme)
- 10-11-44 - CBMU 615, consisting of 5 off. and 272 men arrived Parks from Davisville 5 Oct. (O9TWK2238 Oct'44 from Parks to Budocks)
- 10-30-44 - CBMU 615 arrived Hueneme from Parks 21 Oct'44. (Hueneme conf. disp to CNO 232323 NCR 1155 dtd 24 Oct'44).
- 2-1-45 - CBMU 615 scheduled for BIVE. (CNO Sec Disp to Cincpoa 181821 dtd 18 Jan'45)
- 5-12-45 - CBMU 615 arrived 1 May'45 at Hueneme from Mira Loma, Calif with 5 off. and 273 men. (Hueneme TWX 032109 May'45 to Bupers)
- 5-22-45 - CBMU 615 departed for overseas 17 May'45 with 4 off. and 268 men. (Hueneme conf disp 181847 May'45 to Bupers)
- 8-17-45 - ComAirPac sec report on status of Naval Aircraft service units in Pacific area dtd 2 Aug shows CBMU 615 located with Acorn 44 on Okinawa.
- 8-21-45 - 1 Aug '45 report of CBMU 615 - location not stated. Unit in transit from 17 May to 6 July 1945.

- 1-10-46 - Comservpac reqs CNB, Okinawa to inactivate CBMU 615. (Comservpac disp 090210 Jun '46 to CNB at Okinawa).
- 2-18-46 - Inactivation of CBMU 615 completed on 16 January 1946. (NOB Navy 3256 speedtr ser 3-46 (48NCR) dtd 16 Jan 46 to Comservpac).

After serving at Port Hueneme and Mira Loma, Calif., CBMU 615 which was formed at Davisville and trained at Parks, shipped to Okinawa May 17, 1945, and served there to the war's end.

- 5 Oct 1944 - Arrived Camp Parks from HOGC Davisville.
- 21 Oct 1944 - Arrived Huonani from Camp Parks.
- 1 May 1945 - Arrived Huonani from Mira Loma, Calif.
- 17 May 1945 - Departed Huonani for overseas.
- 6 Jul 1945 - Arrived Okinawa.
- 1 Aug 1945 - Located at Okinawa.
