CBMU 636

- 6-13-45 - Comnavforger requests CBMU (636), consisting of 4 off. and 150 men, for maint duties at Bremen and Bremerhaven. Personnel to be furnished by the 69th CB. (Comnaven restr TWX 091718 Jul'45 to CNO)
- 6-30-45 - Except for 4 off. and 150 men which have been formed into CBMU 636 for duty at Bremen and Bremerhaven, the personnel of the 69th CB is staged at Germany for return to U.K. (Dirlantdocs confmemo ADYD-00431 dtd 23 June to Nav Insp Gen-- Copy of conf memo for Adm Stark dtd 15 June "Distribution of CB personnel in the ETO as of 15 Jun'45")
- 7- 3-45 - CBMU 636 activated 2 Jul'45. (Comusbasger restr TWX 021131B to CNO)
- 12-17-45 - 1 Dec'45 report of CBMU 636 - located in Germany (USNAB, Weser River, Bremerhaven).
- 12-30-45 - CBMU 636 reported Davisville, R.I. on 18 Dec'45 and inactivation was completed on 18 Dec'45. (NCTC, Davisville, R.I. NTK 192314 Dec'45 to BuPers).

Our report shows ...

CBMU 635

- 5-26-45 - Ref a (Coml7 to DNO conf ltr ser 00898 of 20 Apr with ends) and ref b (Diradocks to Coml7 restr ltr A-3-1/039/EG3 ADyr-174 dtd 31 Mar) recommends that two CBMUs be formed from the personnel of the 26th CB. In accordance therewith Comservpac is requested to inactivate CB 26 and establish CBMUs 634 and 635 with complements equivalent relatively to Secs I and II of CB 26. Comservpac will advise CNO at such time as subject inactivation and establishments take place. Bupers will assign OinCs of CBMUs and make other necessary changes in personnel required by the above reorganization of CB 26. (CNO conf ltr ser 0207930 dtd 17 May'45 to Comservpac)
- 5-19-45 - In accordance with CNO conf ltr ser 0207930 dtd 17 May, inactivate 26th CB and redesignate 26th CB, Sec 1 as CBMU 634 and 26th CB, Sec 2 as CBMU 635. Inform Comservpac when this action effected. Request you consider submitting recommendations for revised complements for each of these units of approx 7 off. and 270 men as a standard CBMU. Presently authorized complements will continue in effect until revised complements are approved by Comservpac. (Comservpac conf spdltr 02987 dtd 6 June to Coml7)
- 7-14-45 - Request reduction consideration be delayed until 1 Nov'45 pending compl Hula requirement. The Hula activity maint requirement was filled from the 26th CB Secs 1 and 2 without any outside of district assistance. At that time can make suggested reduction in complement. Redesignation 26th CB, Secs 1 and 2 to CBMUs 634 and 635 will be effected on 15 Jul'45. (Coml7 conf disp 082334 July to Comservpac)
- 7-18-45 - 1 Jul'45 report of 26th CB, Sec 2 - Redesignation of this unit as CBMU 635 will be effected on 1 Jul'45.
- 7-27-45 - It is directed that the 26th CB, Sec. II be redesignated as CBMU 635 as of 15 Jul'45. (Coml7 conf. ltr Ser 01508 dtd 10 Jul'45 to OinC 26th CB, Sec. II.)

CBMU 636

Activated at Bremerhaven, Germany July 2, 1945 with men and officers from the 69th Battalion, CBMU 636 was still located in Germany when the Pacific war ended.
