



The Art of Dr. Eddy



Carlton A. Eddy is an Associate Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio. Although by profession a scientist and academician, since childhood he has had a consummate fascination with things aeronautical. Growing up in a career Navy family focused that fascination on naval air.

Several years ago he discovered the talent to artistically portray aviation subjects and has since been active as an artist. An official artist for the Coast Guard, his works have been displayed at the National Museum of Naval Aviation and published in *Naval Aviation News*. Some of his biggest fans are the Sailors aboard *Abraham Lincoln*, who flock to mail call to see what new illustrations adorn the envelopes of Dr. Eddy's letters to his son.
