January	Provided Target Services for the Advance Capability Torpedo (ADCAP) Program at the Atlantic Underwater Test and Evaluation Center (AUTEK)
April - May	Provided ASW and ADCAP target services at AUTEK. Conducted Prospective Commanding Officer (PCO) Operations
June	Commenced Selected Restricted Availability (SRA)
August - September	Completed SRA. Conducted Sound Trials at AUTEK. Commenced Pre-Overseas Movement (POM) workup.
November - December	North Atlantic Deployment

### 3. Narrative

During January and February 1988, USS ALBUQUERQUE provided target services for the ADCAP program at the Atlantic Underway Test and Evaluation Center (AUTEK) in the Bahamas. In May, ALBUQUERQUE conducted Prospective Commanding Officer (PCO) operations. During August and September, ALBUQUERQUE conducted sound trials at AUTEK and upon return to Groton commenced a Pre-Overseas Movement (POM) upkeep. The ALBUQUERQUE completed POM workup in October and went to Norfolk for deperming and weapons load. The ALBUQUERQUE spent November and December on a North Atlantic Deployment.
