

3. Narrative.

The year began making preparations for participation in Joint Task Force Exercise 98-1. During this exercise the crew enjoyed port visits in Port Everglades, Fl and Kings Bay, Ga. Throughout the year ALBUQUERQUE participated in several tactical exercises including MARCOT 98, JTFEX, TACDEVEX 45-98, and COMPTUEX 99-2.

ALBUQUERQUE also completed several significant maintenance milestones. During a five week Drydock period the Nuclear divisions flawlessly completed a Resin discharge, the most complex nuclear maintenance performed on an operational submarine. Many modifications were made to Radio in order to communicate with the Battle Group and allow sailors to send and receive E-mail at sea.

The ship proved its many capabilities by successfully completing several inspections including a Tactical Readiness Evaluation and Operation Reactor Safeguard Examination. Other significant events include Prospective Commanding Officer Operations, a VIP cruise for World War II Submarine Veterans, and short-fused Special Operations in support of National Security.

Submarine Squadron TWO recognized USS ALBUQUERQUE's outstanding performance in 1998 by awarding her the Green Communications "C" and the Red Damage Control "DC". The year ended with the crew taking a much needed break for holiday standown.
