

4. Narrative. In addition to completing the Selected Restricted Availability (SRA), several upkeep periods were accomplished including the Pre-Overseas Movement (POM) upkeep leading up to deployment to the Western Atlantic. ALEXANDRIA was awarded the Tactical "T" for overall strike warfare proficiency and the Communications "C" for excellence in communications for the second consecutive year. Among the VIP's visiting were former crew members of the USS NAUTILUS (SSN 571).
