I. COMMAND COMPOSITION AND ORGANIZATION (U)

(U) USS COLUMBIA (SSN 771) is an improved Los Angeles (SSN 688) class fast attack nuclear submarine. USS COLUMBIA is assigned to the Submarine Force, U.S. Pacific Fleet (CTF 14) with Commander, Submarine Squadron THREE as ISIC.

(U) CDR J.N. ROGERS was the Commanding Officer from 1 January 1998 to 31 December 1998.
