1993 Narrative

1. 1993 was a busy year for the frigate INGRAHAM. She began with the installation of the Combat Systems Operational Sequencing System (CSOSS) and Kingfisher modification to the SQS 56 sonar while still in holiday standdown.
2. Tailored Ship Training Availability II (TSTA II) in mid-January began our intermediate phase of training. Every division was affected by the swarm of Afloat Training Group Pacific (ATGPAC) personnel. With battle group workups around the corner, INGRAHAM's crew worked hard to rapidly assimilate knowledge and training methods from ATG. As February began, the lines between TSTA II, Final Evaluated Problem (FEP), and COMPTUEX 93-7 blurred. Highlights of this period included an SM-1 shot, an EXTORP shot (earning INGRAHAM ASW Ship of the Week honors), and a satisfactory Final Evaluated Problem.
3. Inport time in February gave most of the crew a breather. However, Combat Systems had two more hurdles before the ship could enter FLEETEX 93-2. Combat Systems Readiness Review (CSRR) challenged our electronics and sonar techs' knowledge of their systems. Cruise Missile Test and Evaluation (CMTE) tested Operations Specialists and officer command-and-control teams in the intricacies of Over the Horizon Targeting.
4. FLEETEX 93-2A followed on the heels of CSRR and CMTE. INGRAHAM began the exercise operating with NEW ORLEANS ARG in COMPTUEX 93-11M and cooperating with HALSEY and FORD in their MEFEX. This cross-training proved beneficial as INGRAHAM would operate with these ships. Unfortunately, INGRAHAM was detached on a fruitless SAR mission just prior to the main event-- the Strait of Hormel transit.
5. After a short break, FLEETEX 93-2 continued with missile shooting at PMTC where the Battle Frigate outshot the cruisers PRINCETON and FOX. The remainder of FLEETEX 93-2B was spent practicing for CHARLIE phase. During this evaluated phase, INGRAHAM led the battle group in a contested straits transit and boarded a hostile merchant vessel. In addition, INGRAHAM was a key player in protecting the battle group from the hostile "diesel" submarine PORTSMOUTH. INGRAHAM's efforts earned her COMCARGRU THREE's praise and COMDESRON TWO ONE's Pummeled Dolphin Award as the best ASW unit in the battle group.
6. April brought pre-deployment standdown and a change of command. On 09 April CDR Bradley J. Kaplan relieved CDR Dana L. Vugteveen as Commanding Officer.
7. An underwater inspection in May revealed an underwater tear in the sonar dome requiring an immediate drydocking. INGRAHAM deadsticked to the Naval Shipyard's Drydock Two and remained there for over two weeks. Following replacement of the dome, INGRAHAM participated in the LINCOLN Battle Group at-sea training period.

This was followed by an ISIC Engineering Readiness Assessment (IERA) conducted by COMDESRON NINE.

8. INGRAHAM began her second deployment on 15 June. The LINCOLN Battle Group consisted of ABRAHAM LINCOLN (CVN 72), PRINCETON (CG 59), FOX (CG 33), PASADENA (SSN 752), MOUNT HOOD (AE 29), WILLAMETTE (AO 180), and INGRAHAM. PORTSMOUTH joined the group on the westward transit. Highlights of the transit (TRANSITEX 93-58W) included extensive ASW and MRAAW exercises and a PASSEX with the Japanese Maritime Self-Defense Force (JMSDF).

9. INGRAHAM celebrated Independence Day by conducting a Freedom of Navigation exercise off the south coast of Taiwan. The frigate rejoined LINCOLN and PRINCETON for a four day port visit in Hong Kong. The LINCOLN Battle Group conducted turnover with the NIMITZ Battle Group in the South China Sea and transitted the Straits of Malacca.

10. LINCOLN, PRINCETON, and INGRAHAM detached from FOX and the auxiliaries and proceeded at high speed to the Gulf. During this transit the LINCOLN suffered an F-14 rampstrike while INGRAHAM was plane guard. The frigate conducted SAR operations until HS 6 aircraft recovered both crewmembers. INGRAHAM led LINCOLN and PRINCETON through the Straits of Hormuz on 24 July. After a short stay in Bahrain, the frigate participated in GULFEX XIX with British, French, and other American participants.

11. The Battle Frigate's next mission was to locate the Chinese Motor Vessel YING HE (MILKY WAY), believed to be carrying prohibited cargo for shipment to Iran. One of INGRAHAM's HSL 49 SH-60B helicopters located the vessel and INGRAHAM began shadowing the vessel until she anchored in the Gulf of Oman. INGRAHAM, O'BRIEN (DD 975), and CHANDLER (DDG 996) participated in the surveillance which ended with YING HE proceeding to Saudi Arabia in order to be searched by neutral parties.

12. SHAREM 102 PHASE TWO, involving INGRAHAM, PASADENA, ELLIOT (DD 967), USNS SILAS BENT (T-AGS 26), HS 6 SH-60F helos crossdecked to INGRAHAM, and P-3C aircraft, was conducted in the North Arabian Sea. This high-profile exercise included highly structured detection scenarios in addition to freeplay events.

13. SHAREM was followed by a productive Tender Availability with USS SHENANDOAH (AD 44) in Jebel Ali, UAE. After TAV, INGRAHAM patrolled the North Arabian Gulf prior to EXERCISE EASTERN SAILOR 93-4 in Qatar. This successful exercise was followed by three others with our allies of Bahrain, Kuwait, and the United Arab Emirates (UAE).

14. Following EXERCISE IRON SIREN 94-1 with the Navy of UAE, INGRAHAM began a planned four day port visit to Abu Dhabi. After being pierside for a few hours, INGRAHAM received emergent tasking ordering her to sortie to Somalia to relieve CHANDLER. The Somali AOA was mostly uneventful, although the CIC team was

challenged by being designated as Anti-Air Warfare Commander. Unfortunately, INGRAHAM collided with WILLAMETTE during an UNREP and our port visit to Geraldton, Australia was replaced by a trip to the yards in Singapore.

15. MOUNT HOOD and INGRAHAM transitted the Indian Ocean during the first part of November. MOUNT HOOD detached for a port visit to Phuket, Thailand while INGRAHAM continued to Singapore for a seven day inport period. The team of shipyard workers and ship's crew made INGRAHAM ready to transit the Pacific in the time allotted.

16. Although stormy, the transit to Hawaii (TRANSITEX 94-2E) was relatively uneventful. Preparations for Tiger Cruise, a Tactical Training Strategy assessment, and the admiral's visit were the highlights of INGRAHAM's eastbound transit. INGRAHAM and PASADENA received short-fuzed tasking to conduct shallow water ASW exercise ENCOUNTEREX 94-04 with NAS Barbers Point P-3C aircraft off the French Frigate Shoals.

17. The final leg of deployment featured Tiger Cruise, a chance for the entire battle group to shine. Calmer weather than that experienced on the previous leg helped make the cruise a success. INGRAHAM moored at Naval Station Long Beach Pier Six on 15 December and began a holiday standdown that would stretch into 1994.

COMMAND HISTORIAN NOTES

1. For those not familiar with INGRAHAM, she represents several lasts: last ship of the OLIVER HAZARD PERRY Guided Missile Frigate class, last ship to be built in Todd Shipyard San Pedro, and last major combatant on the west coast. 2. This is my first command history for INGRAHAM. I owe the majority of its contents to LTJG Michael Hendrickson, USN whose diligent efforts are displayed in this document. The basic format is the same as past command histories: the chronology uses Fleet Exercise Publication (FXP and Allied Exercise Publication (AXP) notation for most of the exercises. Of course, IPT stands for inport and U/W stands for underway. Other abbreviations include ECCs (Engineering Casualty Control drills), OBT (SQQ-89 On-Board Trainer, CSTT (Combat System Training Team), DCTT (Damage Control Training Team), and STT (Seamanship Training Team).
