COMMAND HISTORY
USS JARRETT (FFG 33)
CALENDAR YEAR 1984

USS JARRETT (FFG 33) began calendar year 1984 undergoing Post-Shakedown Availability (PSA) at Todd Pacific Shipyard, San Pedro, California. During this yard period, which began in December 1983, modifications to original contract specifications were performed and INSURV discrepancies were corrected. JARRETT left Todd Shipyard in March and returned to Naval Station, Long Beach, her homeport.

Following PSA, JARRETT was confronted with a wave of inspections beginning with Combat Systems Ship's Qualification (CSSQT), which were held in April. In the ensuing months, JARRETT faced her first Supply Management Inspection (SMI), On-Site Disbursing Audit, 3-M Inspection, and Operational Propulsion Plant Examination (OPPE).

On 1 October, after successfully completing all her inspections, JARRETT commenced a six week IMAV at Naval Station, San Diego. This availability period provided the ship an opportunity to receive necessary maintenance as well as undergo minor alterations. JARRETT completed IMAV in mid-November. The year ended with four weeks of Refresher Training which was coupled with the Varsity Player training exercise.

In summary, the year saw JARRETT complete the metamorphosis from a newly commissioned ship with an inexperienced crew to a combat ready, active part of the fleet preparing for her upcoming deployment in July 1985.

The following time line provides more detailed information concerning specific events which occurred during 1984.

2.(C) USS JARRETT is recommended for Combat Systems departmental awards for the ASW "A", GUNNERY "E", and MISSILE "E". The competitive cycle started one day prior to USS JARRETT's commissioning. Since that day, the Combat Systems Department has steadily progressed to a high state of material and training readiness. In all three areas STAR training is on track in accordance with the STAR FFG-7 training module. Strict adherence to established maintenance practices, PMS and all required STAR exercises have resulted in a sustained superior performance for ASW, Gunnery, and Missiles. Combat Systems Department achieved a grade of 93% in the annual TYCOM 3-M Inspection.

ASW:

ASW-1-R: As of 6 December 84, USS JARRETT is midway through a four week period of Refresher Training. FTG observed ASW-4-I (SVTT torpedo shot) and ASW-12-I (LAMPS torpedo drop) exercises against an SSN 688 class submarine were successfully completed. Particular noteworthy is the fact that this was the first time an ASW-2-I exercise has been completed by a ship during REFTRA.

ASW-2-R: Approximately 58 hours of CAST were conducted during the first two weeks of REFTRA. The ASW team effectively demonstrated the ability to coordinate and properly utilize varied surface and air ASW assets against both diesel and nuclear powered submarines.

ASW-3-R: USS JARRETT successfully completed ASW Team Evaluation (Phase I) (non-graded) in March 1984.

ASW-4-R: ASW Team Evaluation (Phase I) (graded) was successfully completed in March 1984 with a final score of 88%.

ASW-5-R: ASW Team Evaluation (Phase II) (graded) was successfully completed in October 1984 with a score of 85%.

Additionally, USS JARRETT has been an active participant in the Long Beach Naval Station ROOFTOP Training Program. Our success in that program resulted in being named runner-up in the first quarterly Long Beach trainer excellence award.


Gunnery & Missiles:

USS JARRETT successfully completed Shakedown Combat Systems Ship Qualification Trials (CSSQT) (MAR 84) during this competitive cycle. Two evaluated SML (MR) hits, in addition to shooting down a TDU by CIWS and a successful modified ASU-1-R were included in CSSQT. Since then, a self observed ASU-1-R was conducted. USS JARRETT has not had the opportunity to complete an AAW-1R because of limited SURFPAC training assets. USS JARRETT does, however, have an AAW-2-R scheduled during REFTRA (12 December) and another ASU-1-R (week of 10 December) scheduled. Scores of these exercises will be submitted to CDS-13 as soon as possible.

During the first two weeks of REFTRA, USS JARRETT successfully completed several AAW exercises including an AAW-4-I (TACTICAL AAW) in which a score of 100% was achieved.

USS JARRETT is among one of only 17 ships in the Navy that has not suffered a casualty to its MK 15 CIWS in the last 10 months.

In conclusion, USS JARRETT Combat Systems continues to improve, but even at its intermediate stage of development is head and shoulders above most of its counterparts in ASW, Gunnery and Missiles. Awards in these areas are strongly recommended.
