01 JAN 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE STARTED 1992 IN A HOLIDAY STANDDOWN PERIOD BERTHED AT PIER 23 AT THE NAVAL OPERATING BASE IN NORFOLK, VA.

04 JAN 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE ENDED OVERHAUL AT PIER 23, BERTH 6, NAVAL OPERATING BASE, NORFOLK, VIRGINIA.

06 JAN 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE DEPARTED NORFOLK FOR POST-OVERHAUL ACOUSTIC TRIALS.

26 JAN 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE COMPLETED WEAPONS SYSTEM ACCURACY TESTING IN TONGUE OF THE OCEAN, BAHAMAS.

01 FEB 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE SWITCHED ADMINISTRATIVE CHAIN OF COMMAND FROM COMMANDER SUBMARINE GROUP SIX, CHARLESTON, SOUTH CAROLINA TO COMMANDER SUBMARINE GROUP TWO IN NEW LONDON, CONNETICUT.

12 FEB 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE COMPLETED A TWO-DAY INSPECTION CONDUCTED BY THE U.S. NAVY'S BOARD OF INSPECTION AND SURVEY (INSURV), WHICH INCLUDED AN UNDERWAY MATERIAL INSPECTION (UMI).

18 FEB 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE HOSTED A TOUR FOR MID-GRADE OFFICERS ASSIGNED TO ARMED FORCES STAFF COLLEGE.

02 APR 1992 HOSTED A VISIT BY 45 MEMBERS OF THE YOUNG PRESIDENTS ORGANIZATION.

05 APR 1992 LT PAUL SIEGRIST RELIEVED LT ROY MUSTELIER AS COMBAT SYSTEMS OFFICER.

10 APR 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE CONDUCTED PHASE III SONAR CERTIFICATION IN THE VIRGINIA CAPES OPERATING AREAS.

01 MAY 1992 LT JOHN MULLIGAN, REPORTED ABOARD AS PROSPECTIVE COMBAT SYSTEMS OFFICER.

19 MAY 1992 LT JOHN MULLIGAN RELIEVED LT PAUL SIEGRIST AS COMBAT SYSTEMS OFFICER. LT SIEGRIST RETAINS DUTIES AS NAVIGATOR/OPERATIONS OFFICER.

22 MAY 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE COMPLETED CONVENTIONAL WEAPONS CERTIFICATION.

29 JUN 1992 COMPLETED BATTERY CHANGEOUT PIERSIDE AT NAVAL OPERATIONS BASE, NORFOLK, VIRGINIA.

19 AUG 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE HOSTED AN ORIENTATION TOUR FOR A GROUP OF DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE AGENCY ANALYSTS FROM THE OFFICE FOR RESEARCH AND ASSESSMENTS.

28 AUG 1992 CDR WILLIAM MATZELEVICH REPORTED ABOARD AS PROSPECTIVE COMMANDING OFFICER OF USS JACKSONVILLE.

17 SEP 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE COMPLETED A TWO DAY OPERATIONAL REACTOR SAFEGUARDS EXAMINATION.

26 SEP 1992 COMMANDER WILLIAM MATZELEVICH RELIEVED COMMANDER TIMOTHY TRAVERSO AS COMMANDING OFFICER, USS JACKSONVILLE.

28 SEP 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE COMPLETED A FOUR-DAY COMMUNICATIONS READINESS EXAMINATION (CRE).

16 OCT 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE CONDUCTED AN 8 HOUR AT-SEA MEDIA EMBARKATION WITH TELEVISION NEWS CREWS FROM JACKSONVILLE'S NBC AFFILIATE WTLV.

22 OCT 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE RETURNED TO NORFOLK, VIRGINIA AFTER CONDUCTING JOINT US-UK OPERATIONS IN AUTEK, VISITING FT. LAUDERDALE FOR BROWARD NAVY DAYS, AND PARTICIPATING IN A SEAPOWERS DEMONSTRATION FOR THE CHIEF OF THE INDIAN NAVAL STAFF, ADMIRAL RAMDAS.

23 OCT 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE HOSTED A TOUR FOR GENERAL SIR GARRY JOHNSON, KCB OBE MC (BRITISH ARMY), COMMANDER IN CHIEF ALLIED FORCES NORTHERN EUROPE. GENERAL JOHNSON WAS ESCORTED BY VICE ADMIRAL CHILES, COMMANDER SUBMARINE FORCE ATLANTIC FLEET.

24 OCT 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE HOSTED A TOUR FOR FOURTEEN SUBMARINE VETERANS FROM THE USS BREEM (SS 239).

19 NOV 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE ARRIVED IN KINGS BAY, GEORGIA FOR AN EMERGENT DRY-DOCKING.

20 NOV 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE ENTERED DRYDOCK USS OAK RIDGE (ARDM-1) TO COMMENCE DOCKING REPARIS.

07 DEC 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE HOSTED LUNCH AND BRIEF TOUR ABOARD FOR REAR ADMIRAL (LOWER HALF) T. ROBERTSON, USN, COMMANDER SUBMARINE GROUP TEN, AND CAPT H. JACKSON, USN (RET).

14 DEC 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE UNDOCKED FROM USS OAK RIDGE (ARDM-1) AT KINGS BAY, GA. AND COMMENCED FINAL INTERFERENCE REINSTALLATION.

19 DEC 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE RETURNED TO HOMEPORT OF NORFOLK, VA FOLLOWING EMERGENT DRYDOCKING IN KINGS BAY, GA AND PREPARED FOR DEPERM.

23 DEC 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE COMPLETED A THREE DAY DEPERMING AT THE MAGNETIC SILENCING FACILITY, NORFOLK, VA AND RETURNED PIERSIDE AT NAVAL OPERATING BASE TO COMMENCE A BRIEF HOLIDAY STANDDOWN.

31 DEC 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE ENDED 1992 IN A HOLIDAY STANDDOWN PERIOD BERTHED AT PIER 21 AT THE NAVAL OPERATING BASE IN NORFOLK, VA.

01 JAN 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE STARTED 1992 IN A HOLIDAY STANDDOWN PERIOD BERTHED AT PIER 23 AT THE NAVAL OPERATING BASE IN NORFOLK, VA.

04 JAN 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE ENDED OVERHAUL AT PIER 23, BERTH 6, NAVAL OPERATING BASE, NORFOLK, VIRGINIA.

06 JAN 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE DEPARTED NORFOLK FOR POST-OVERHAUL ACOUSTIC TRIALS.

26 JAN 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE COMPLETED WEAPONS SYSTEM ACCURACY TESTING IN TONGUE OF THE OCEAN, BAHAMAS. DURING THE UNDERWAY PERIOD, CONDUCTED A FIVE-DAY PORT VISIT IN PORT EVERGLADES, FLORIDA.

01 FEB 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE SWITCHED ADMINISTRATIVE CHAIN OF COMMAND FROM COMMANDER SUBMARINE GROUP SIX, CHARLESTON, SOUTH CAROLINA TO COMMANDER SUBMARINE GROUP TWO IN NEW LONDON, CONNETICUT.

12 FEB 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE COMPLETED A TWO-DAY INSPECTION CONDUCTED BY THE U.S. NAVY'S BOARD OF INSPECTION AND SURVEY (INSURV), WHICH INCLUDED AN UNDERWAY MATERIAL INSPECTION (UMI).

18 FEB 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE HOSTED A TOUR FOR MID-GRADE OFFICERS ASSIGNED TO ARMED FORCES STAFF COLLEGE CLASS 92-1A SEMINAR 08. THE TOUR PROVIDED THE OFFICERS, MOST OF WHOM WERE NON-NAVY, WITH AN UNDERSTANDING OF THE MISSIONS, ROLES, AND CAPABILITIES OF THE ATTACK SUBMARINE FORCE.

02 APR 1992 HOSTED A VISIT BY 45 MEMBERS OF THE YOUNG PRESIDENTS ORGANIZATION.

05 APR 1992 LT PAUL SIEGRIST RELIEVED LT ROY MUSTELIER AS COMBAT SYSTEMS OFFICER. LT MUSTELIER IS BEING TRANSFERRED TO SUBMARINE SQUADRON EIGHT FOR TEMPORARY DUTY. LT SIEGRIST RETAINS DUTIES AS NAVIGATOR AND OPERATIONS OFFICER.

10 APR 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE CONDUCTED PHASE III SONAR CERTIFICATION IN THE VIRGINIA CAPES OPERATING AREAS. PASSED WITH AN OVERALL EVALUATION OF ABOVE AVERAGE.

10 MAY 1992 DURING UNDERWAY OPERATIONS TO PROVIDE TARGET SERVICES AT AUTEC, USS JACKSONVILLE HOSTED BART DAVIS. MR. DAVIS IS AUTHOR OF THREE MOVIES AND SEVEN NOVELS, INCLUDING FULL FATHOM FIVE, RAISE THE RED DAWN, AND DESTROY THE KENTUCKY. EVOLUTIONS OBSERVED WHILE UNDERWAY INCLUDED BATTLESTATIONS, A TORPEDO HOT-RUN AND FLOODING DRILL, AND AN EMERGENCY BLOW FROM DEEP. HE IS CURRENTLY WRITING TWO BOOKS, ONE NON-FICTION TITLED "BLUE AND GOLD: THE MAKING OF A SUBMARINE CAPTAIN" AND A FICTION WORK TITLED "ATLANTIC RUN" FEATURING THE USS JACKSONVILLE.

19 MAY 1992 LT JOHN MULLIGAN RELIEVED LT PAUL SIEGRIST AS COMBAT SYSTEMS OFFICER. LT SIEGRIST RETAINS DUTIES AS NAVIGATOR/OPERATIONS OFFICER.

22 MAY 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE COMPLETED CONVENTIONAL WEAPONS CERTIFICATION. EVALUATION WAS BELOW AVERAGE IN TORPEDOES, AVERAGE IN HARPOON AND ABOVE AVERAGE IN TOMAHAWK.

29 JUN 1992 COMPLETED BATTERY CHANGEOUT PIERSIDE AT NAVAL OPERATIONS BASE, NORFOLK, VIRGINIA.

13 JUL 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE CONDUCTED A THREE-DAY PORT CALL TO MAYPORT, FLORIDA AS A HOME-CITY PORT VISIT. THE SHIP HOSTED NUMEROUS GUESTS, INCLUDING MEMBERS OF THE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND CITY COUNCIL FOR A DINNER IN THE WARDROOM.

21 JUL 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE COMPLETED NUCLEAR WEAPONS ACCEPTANCE INSPECTION WITH A GRADE OF SATISFACTORY, BEING EVALUATED AS OUTSTANDING IN SEVEN OF ELEVEN AREAS AND EXCELLENT IN ALL OTHERS.

03 AUG 1992 JACKSONVILLE COMPLETED UNDERWAY OPERATIONS THAT INCLUDED CROSS-DECKING UNDERWAY MEMBERS OF PATROL SQUADRON FIVE, THE "MAD FOXES" STATIONED AT NAS JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA.

14 AUG 1992 ADMIRAL B. DEMARS (NAVSEA 08) VISITED USS JACKSONVILLE.

19 AUG 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE HOSTED ON ORIENTATION TOUR FOR A GROUP OF DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE AGENCY ANALYSTS FROM THE OFFICE FOR RESEARCH AND ASSESSMENTS.

28 AUG 1992 CDR WILLIAM MATZELEVICH REPORTED ABOARD AS PROSPECTIVE COMMANDING OFFICER OF USS JACKSONVILLE.

17 SEP 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE COMPLETED A TWO DAY OPERATIONAL REACTOR SAFEGUARDS EXAMINATION.

26 SEP 1992 COMMANDER WILLIAM MATZELEVICH RELIEVED COMMANDER TIMOTHY TRAVERSO AS COMMANDING OFFICER, USS JACKSONVILLE IN CEREMONIES AT ASW TRAINING CENTER AT NORFOLK OPERATING BASE, NORFOLK, VIRGINIA. CEREMONIES WERE HELD INSIDE DUE TO THE PASSING OF TROPICAL STORM DANIELLE. CDR TRAVERSO WILL PROCEED TO DUTY ON THE SEVENTH FLEET STAFF AS SPACE AND ELECTRONIC WARFARE COMMANDER.

28 SEP 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE COMPLETED A FOUR-DAY COMMUNICATIONS READINESS EXAMINATION (CRE) WITH AN OVERALL GRADE OF AVERAGE AND AN ABOVE AVERAGE IN OPERATIONS. A NOTABLE ACCOMPLISHMENT FOR A JUNIOR RADIOROOM ON THE BOAT'S FIRST CRE IN FOUR AND ONE-HALF YEARS.

22 OCT 1992 USS JACKSONVILLE RETURNED TO NORFOLK, VIRGINIA AFTER CONDUCTING JOINT OPERATIONS FOR THE JOINT US-USK SURFACE SHIP TORPEDO DEFENSE PROGRAM IN AUTEC WITH VARIOUS US AND UK SURFACE, AIR AND SUBSURFACE UNITS, INCLUDING BRITISH DIESEL SUBMARINE HMS ORACLE AND BRITISH NUCLEAR ATTACK SUBMARINE HMS TRIUMPH. DURING THE OPERATIONS WITH HMS ORACLE, JACKSONVILLE HOSTED A COOKOUT TOPSIDE WITH MEMBERS OF ORACLE'S CREW WHILE LYING TO OFF SITE 1 AUTEC AND WAS VISITED BY HER COMMANDING OFFICER. APPROXIMATELY TEN MEMBERS OF JACKSONVILLE'S CREW EMBARKED ORACLE FOR A SHORT DIESEL FAMILIARIZATION VISIT, WHICH INCLUDED SUBMERGED OPERATIONS. VISITED PORT EVERGLADES, FLORIDA AS PART OF FT. LAUDERDALE'S "BROWARD DAYS" CELEBRATION. DURING BROWARD NAVY DAYS, JACKSONVILLE HOSTED TOURS FOR INVITED PERSONS, INCLUDING THE LIEUTENANT AND CAPTAIN OF THE BROWARD COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT. DURING THE RETURN TRANSIT FROM PORT EVERGLADES, JACKSONVILLE PARTICIPATED IN A SEAPOWERS DEMONSTRATION FOR THE CHIEF OF THE INDIAN NAVAL STAFF, ADMIRAL RAMDAS HOSTED BY THE CHIEF OF NAVAL OPERATIONS. JACKSONVILLE'S PARTICIPATION CONSISTED OF AN EMERGENCY SURFACING 1000 YARDS ABEAM THE USS THEODORE ROOSEVELT WITH THE USS HUE CITY AND USS FAHRION ON STATION ASTERN ROOSEVELT. FOLLOWING THE DEMONSTRATION, WHICH CONSISTED OF LIVE-FIRE EXERCISES BY A-6, F-14, AND F-18 AIRCRAFT AS WELL AS FLY-BYS BY S-3 AND E-2 AIRCRAFT, JACKSONVILLE SUBMERGED AND PROCEEDED INTO PORT ON SEPERATE TASKING.
