BASIC HISTORY

USS LOS ANGELES (SSN688) began 1982 with local operations, and was assigned as Ready SSN from 18 to 29 January. Significant events which occurred during this early part of 1982 were visits by Under Secretary of the Navy Goodrich on 20 January and the Honorable Eileen Anderson, Major of Honolulu on 2 February. On 8 February, LOS ANGELES was underway for the Pacific Missile Range Facility, Barking Sands, Kauai for MK48 torpedo proficiency firings with RADM B. M. Kauderer, COMSUBPAC embarked. On 13 February, she continued local operations until 15 March when she got underway for Puget Sound, Washington and moored at Carr Inlet, Puget Sound on 22 March for Acoustic Trails. On 29 March, LOS ANGELES was underway again for Esquimalt, BC arriving that same day for a three day visit. On 2 April, she departed Esquimalt, BC and transited to SUBASE San Diego, CA conducting Acoustic Trails at the Santa Cruz Acoustic Range Facility enroute. On 8 April she departed San Diego, CA and commenced her participation in Exercise RIMPAC 82. Upon completion of that exercise she returned to Pearl Harbor, HI, and was inspected in conjunction with the NEY Award competition. LOS ANGELES was awarded Third Place in the Small Afloat category. On 3 May, she was drydocked in COMPETENT (AFDM6) for a period of approximately two months for a Shipyard Selected Restricted Availability (SRA) conducted by Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard. On 25 June she was undocked. On 29 June, LOS ANGELES conducted dock trails. The Consular Corps of Honolulu visited the ship on 22 July. On 31 July LOS ANGELES was underway to conduct Post Selected Restricted Availability Sea Trails. On 9 August she conducted MK48 Proficiency Firings and on 12 August conducted Fleet Operational Readiness Accuracy Checks. On 30 August LOS ANGELES was underway on Prospective Commanding Officer operations and arrived in Lahina, Maui on 3 September. After a brief stay in Lahina, LOS ANGELES conducted a dependent's cruise on her return transit to Pearl Harbor. On 15 September, she was drydocked in COMPETENT (AFDM6) for replacement of her secondary propulsion motor and was undocked on 24 September. On 3 October, USS LOS ANGELES was awarded the Antisubmarine "A" for Antisubmarine Warfare Excellence. The Korean Chief of Naval Operations visited the ship on 9 October. On 19 October, she conducted at sea Pre-Overseas Movement Certification, and on 15 November was underway for WESTPAC and the Indian Ocean. On 22 November, she came under the operational control of CTF SEVEN FOUR. On 28 November LOS ANGELES arrived in Subic Bay, Republic of the Philippines and moored alongside USS PROTEUS (AS19). On 7 December LOS ANGELES crossed the Equator and was visited by Neptunis Rex.
