BASIC HISTORY

USS LOS ANGELES (SSN 688) began 1987 under the operational control of Commander Task Force SEVEN FOUR while underway in the Western Pacific Ocean. This was followed by upkeep in Subic Bay, Republic of the Philippines and Guam, USA and a port call in Hong Kong, during which the ship hosted the U.S. Consulate General, Mr. Don Anderson and his guests. LOS ANGELES again deployed on 6 March with a short port visit in Yokosuka, Japan, where RADM Tadashi Soto, COMSUBFLT JMSDF and his staff visited. LOS ANGELES then transited to homeport of Pearl Harbor, HI. An Operational Reactor Safeguards Examination was conducted during the transit.

After a standdown and upkeep period, USS LOS ANGELES conducted several major underway inspections including a MK 48 Torpedo Certification, Service Weapons Test, and a Tactical Readiness Evaluation. Midshipman training, fleet training services, a visit by Edwin Meese, US Attorney General, and a Nuclear Weapons Acceptance Inspection completed the summer's activities. On 1 October LOS ANGELES was awarded the Navy "E" and Supply "E" for fiscal year 1987.

In November, LOS ANGELES deployed to the operational control of Commander, Submarine Group NINE for exercise ASWOPS 88A/SHAREM 72 CANUS followed by a port visit in Long Beach, CA.

On 11 December, Commander D. I. Stanley, USN was relieved by Commander J. K. Eldridge, USN as Commanding Officer, USS LOS ANGELES.
