USS MIAMI (SSN 755)
COMMAND HISTORY - 1994

1. Command Composition and Organization:

Commander Don H. Potter, USN, commands USS MIAMI (SSN 755) homeported at Groton, CT, with Commander Submarine Development Squadron TWELVE as his immediate superior in command.

2. Chronology:

1 - 3 January 1994: Inport Groton

4 January 1994: Underway for ORSE.

18 - 29 January 1994: Underway for Torpedo Certification Proficiency.

30 January 1994: Inport SUBASE Groton, CT.

31 January 1994 - 17 March 1994: Drydocking for Selected Restricted Availability (SRA), SHIPPINGPORT (ARDM 4), SUBASE Groton, CT.

18 March 1994: Undock from SHIPPINGPORT (ARDM 4).

19 - 28 March 1994: Inport SUBASE Groton, CT.

29 - 30 March 1994: Underway for SRA Sea Trials.

31 March 1994 - 10 April 1994: Inport SUBASE Groton, CT.

11 - 25 April 1994: Underway for Logistics Readiness Evaluation (LRE), Mine Warfare Readiness Certification (MRCI), Minefield Penetration Operations, Acoustic Trials at Exuma, Bahamas, and Anti-Diesel Operations with USS PROVIDENCE (SSN 719).

25 - 28 April 1994: Inport SUBASE Groton, CT.

28 - 30 April 1994: Underway for PCO OPS.

30 April - 8 May 1994: Inport SUBASE Groton, CT.

9 May - 13 May 1994: POM Work Up.

14 May - 22 May 1994: Inport SUBASE Groton, CT.

23 May - 27 May 1994: POM Certification with COMSUBDEVRON TWELVE onboard.

28 May - 31 May 1994: Inport SUBASE Groton, CT.

1 June - 16 September 1994: Deployed to Red Sea/Arabian Gulf on first ever SUBLANT unit deployment to the area; first ever United States nuclear submarine transit of the Suez Canal; first ever subordinate submarine deployment to COMUSNAVCENT. Conducted multi-national exercises, multiple VIP/Press tours/PROJECT HANDCLASP for foreign nationals, and various submarine operations. During this deployment, MIAMI made port visits to Souda Bay (Crete), Jeddah (Saudi Arabia), Manama (Bahrain), Abu Dhabi (United Arab Emirates) and La Maddelena (Sardinia).

14 September - 16 September: Conduct an unscheduled Operational Reactor Safeguards Examination (ORSE).

16 September: Moor SUBASE Groton, CT; homecoming from Arabian Gulf deployment.

17 September - 2 October 1994: Post deployment standdown, SUBASE Groton Ct.

3 October - 6 November 1994: IMA Upkeep period, SUBASE Groton CT.

7 November - 22 November 1994: Underway for Canadian Readiness and PCO Ops.

23 November - 7 December 1994: Inport SUBASE Groton CT.

8 December - 17 December 1994: Underway for local operations in the NBOA's.

18 - 31 December 1994: Christmas Standdown Period, inport SUBASE Groton CT; MIAMI is awarded the Commander, Submarine Development Squadron TWELVE Blue "E" for Supply Excellence.
