COMMAND HISTORY - 1995**

1. Command Composition and Organization:

Commander Larry B. Olsen, USN, commands USS MIAMI (SSN 755) homeported at Groton, CT, with Commander Submarine Development Squadron TWELVE as his immediate superior in command. He relieved Commander Don H. Potter Jr. and assumed command on 19 January 1996.

- 22 - 25 May 1995: Underway to support USS CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI (SSN 705) Pre-Overseas Movement (POM) workup.
- 26 May - 4 June 1995: Inport SUBASE Groton, CT.
- 5 - 14 June 1995: Underway for Pre-Overseas Movement (POM) workup.
- 15 - 25 June 1995: Inport SUBASE Groton, CT.
- 26 - 30 June 1995: Underway for Pre-Overseas Movement (POM) certification with Commander, Submarine Development Squadron TWELVE onboard.
- 1 - 9 July 1995: Inport SUBASE Groton, CT.
- 10 - 11 July 1995: Underway for Western Atlantic (WESTLANT) deployment.
- 12 July 1995: Inport SUBASE Groton, CT for emergent repairs.
- 13 July - 15 November 1995: Underway for Western Atlantic (WESTLANT) deployment.
