Task Organization: NMCB-6 Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company (herein known as the Company) (See Annex A)

1. Situation. In accordance with reference (a), the Company will depart NAS Quonset Point o/a 15 August 1969 to undergo military training at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, commencing 18 August 1969, for a period of about two weeks. The First Battalion, Second Marines is serving as the host Battalion and will provide training in Crew-Served Weapons. The conditions are as follows:

- a. Enemy Forces: None
- b. Friendly Forces: SERVLANT, 2nd MARDIV, FMFLANT, CBC Davisville, MARCORBASE, CAMLEJ, MCB SEVEN, TWENTY-FIRST NCR, COMCBLANT
- c. Attachment: Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company from MCB SEVEN.

2. Mission. Deploy a Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company of approximately 300 men to Camp Lejeune in conjunction with general military training and the use of Crew-served weapons.

3. Execution When directed on or about 15 August 1969, the Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company will depart Davisville, Rhode Island and deploy to Camp Lejeune for approximately two weeks. While in training and during transit, the Company will maintain the same readiness condition as NMCB SIX. This OPORD is effective for planning upon receipt and for execution when deployed.

4. Administration and Logistics

- a. Standard Operational procedures set forth by reference (b), will be followed.

b. Leave will be administered in accordance with reference (c).

5. Command and Communications.

a. The Officer-in-Charge of MCB SIX Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company is directed to report to CG, MARCORBASE, Camp Lejeune in accordance with Article 1324, U. S. Navy Regulations.

b. In accordance with reference (a) the Officer-in-Charge of MCB SIX Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company will assume OPCON for MCB SEVEN Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company while attached for this training period.

c. Movement reports will be made in accordance with reference (d).

d. Requests for communication guard will be submitted to CG, MARCORBASE, Camp Lejeune.

e. In accordance with reference (a) direct liaison is authorized with MCB SEVEN, MARCORBASE, and component activities.
