5-13-43 - Det. 1004 arrived Argentina 17 March to join with 1st Section 17th CB forming complete 17th CB. - 20 officer and 1029 men.

This unit was formed at Norfolk, Va., in December, 1942, and transferred to Davisville, Jan. 5, 1943. The Detachment embarked from Davisville March 13, 1943, and landed in Argentia, Newfoundland four days later. It was then assigned to the 17th Battalion and became a part of that unit on March 17, 1943.

- 5 Jan 1943 - Transferred to ABD, Davisville, R. I.

- 17 Mar 1943 - Arrived Argentia. Combines with 17th CB 1st Section to form the 17th CB as of this date.
