- 6-29-44 - 92nd CB detached from 7th Reg. (7th Reg. ltr 7CR/01-PLA/pln over P16-3/00/44 over Ser 0302 to 92nd CB dtd 15 Jun'44 - 1st end. on 2nd Brig. orders)
- 7- 6-44 - Officers and men detached from 7th Reg. and 2nd Brig. and ordered to report to 5th Brig. for duty. (OinC 2nd Brig ltr 2M0Br-06-HCB/kb over P16-3 6999 dtd 14 Jun)
- 7- 7-44 - 1 Jun'44 report of 92nd CB - all work at Oahu secured 27 May'44.
- 8- 9-44 - 1 Jul'44 report of 92nd CB - 92nd CB secured all work projects at Pearl Harbor area on 27 May'44.
- 8- 9-44 - 1 Jul'44 report of 7th Reg. - 15 off. and 414 men of the 92nd CB have embarked for forward area and remainder expected to embark in early Jul'44.
- 9-15-44 - Lt. (jg) C.K. Jackson and 23 men ordered detached from Gropac 6 (temp duty) and to report back to the 92nd CB for duty (SerForPacFlt Gropac 6 Conf. ltr P16-4(3)/00 over JWR:ff Ser. 165 to subj officer dtd 1 Sep'44)
- 10-17-44 - Det. 1035 turned over operations to 92nd CB on Tinian 11 Aug'44. (Det. 1035's report on operations on the Marianna Islands)
- 11-30-44 - 1 Nov'44 report of 92nd CB - no info on location. Report endorsed by 29th Reg.
- 12- 1-44 - 1 Aug'44 report of 92nd CB - Batt enroute to forward area during Jul'44.
- 12- 5-44 - 1 Oct'44 report of 92nd CB - Report delayed due to the fact that the records were with the rear echelon. Report endorsed by the 29th Regiment.
- 1-5-45 - 1 Dec'44 report of the 92nd CB - no info on location. Report endorsed by 29th Reg.
- 1-15-45 - 1 Dec'44 report of the 29th Regiment - The 92nd CB rec'd 10 men during Nov'44.
- 2- 7-45 - 1 Jan'45 report of the 92nd CB - location not stated. Report endorsed by the 29th Regiment. Det. 1065 on temp duty with the 92nd CB while assigned as specialists in connection with the installation of Diesel Electric Generators which will comprise a part of the Island Power and Transmission System.

92nd Construction Battalion (INACTIVATED)

92ND BATTALION

After being formed at Camp Peary in May 1943, the 92nd was sent to Endicott for advanced training, then to Hueneme, arriving there Aug. 4, 1943. The Battalion left Hueneme in three echelons, the last arriving at Oahu Oct. 2. The entire Battalion was stationed on Oahu until Feb. 2, 1944, when a detachment of 95 men was sent to Kauai for temporary duty with the 99th. The detachment returned April 27. During May and June 1944, small detachments were sent out on duty with GroPac 6 and 8 and the 6th NC Brigade, these detachments arriving at Saipan shortly after D-Day. The main body of the 92nd left Oahu in sections during June and July, arriving at Tinian throughout August. On Sept. 1, the Gro-Pac duty men were transferred to the main body of the 92nd on Tinian. The last echelon from Oahu arrived Sept. 18. The Battalion was still on duty with the 6th NC Brigade on Tinian when the war ended.

Itinerary of 92nd U.S. Naval Construction Battalion

- 26 May 1943: Battalion formed at NCTC, Camp Peary.
- 3 June 1943: Battalion departed NCTC, Camp Peary.
- 4 June 1943: Arrived NCTC, Camp Endicott for advance training.
- 29 July 1943: Departed NCTC, Camp Endicott for Camp Parks, but diverted enroute to ABD, Port Hueneme.
- 4 August 1943: Arrived ABD, Port Hueneme, California.
- 5 Sept. 1943: 1st Echelon of two (2) Officers and two (2) men departed ABD, Port Hueneme.
- 11 Sept. 1943: 1st Echelon arrived Oahu, T.H.
- 15 Sept. 1943: 2nd Echelon of four (4) Officers and two hundred and twenty-one (221) men departed ABD, Port Hueneme, California.
- 19 Sept. 1943: 2nd Echelon arrived Oahu, T.H.
- 28 Sept. 1943: 3rd Echelon of twenty-four (24) Officers and eight hundred and ten (810) enlisted men departed ABD, Port Hueneme, California.
- 2 October 1943: 3rd Echelon arrived Oahu, T.H.
- 2 Feb. 1944: Two (2) Officers and ninety-five (95) enlisted men on temporary duty with the 99th M.C.B. Detachment on Hawaii, T.H.
- 27 April 1944: Detachment returned to Oahu, T.H.
- 8 May 1944: Group 169A-No.2 and No.3, each containing one (1) Officer and twenty-five (25) men departed for temporary duty with GroPac 3.
- 9 May 1944: Group 169A, No.1 of one (1) Officer and twenty-four (24) men departed from Oahu for temporary duty with GroPac 3.
- 18 June 1944: Group 169 of four (4) enlisted men departed Oahu, for temporary duty with 6th M.C. Brigade.
