- 11-14-44 - 110th CB moved to Tinian. (Com Marshall Gilberts Area to Comserforpacflt Sec. ltr P16-1/MM/00/J2-mb over Ser 00932 dtd 3 Nov'44)
- 11-30-44 - 1 Nov'44 report of 110th CB - no info on location. Report endorsed by 30th Reg.

9-3-43 - CNO orders transfer of the 110th CB from Peary to Gulfport on 8 Sep'43. (Conf. disp. 031339 NCR 9177 from CNO to Peary)

10-14-43 - CNO orders transfer of the 110th CB to Hueneme on 17 Oct'43. Assigned Acorn 22. (Conf. Disp. 141341 NCR 6230 dtd 14 Oct from CNO to Gulfport)

12-9-43 - 110th CB left for embarkation point 22 Nov'43. (RHD)

3-24-44 - 110th CB located at Eniwetok, Marshalls. (Comairpac sec. disp. 221904 Mar'44 to Cincpoa)

6-8-44 - 1 May'44 report of 110th CB - Left U.S. 22 Nov'43 and arrived at P.H. 1 Dec'43. Left P.H. 10 Feb'44 for duty in Pacific area. (Report of 110th CB - no date)

7-10-44 - 110th CB was operating at EBRD Iroquois Pt. from 1 Dec'43 to 31 Jan'44. (1 Dec'43 to 31 Jan'44 report from the 110th CB)

7-20-44 - 1 Mar'44 report of 110th CB - 1st group of the batt sailed from P.H. on 19 Feb'44 and the second group on 12 Feb. 2nd Group arrived Eniwetok 20 Feb and landed 22 Feb. First group landed at Eniwetok 23 Feb'44.

10-9-44 - According to the 1 Sep'44 report of CBMU 592, the 110th CB is located at Eniwetok. 1st endorsement to report by CNAB Eniwetok states that upon the departure of the 110th CB, CBMU 592 will be augmented by personnel from CBMU 594 from Engebi Is.

110th Construction Battalion (INACTIVATED)

110TH BATTALION

Commissioned at Camp Peary Aug. 12, 1943, the 110th Battalion moved through Gulfport, Miss., and arrived at Port Hueneme on Oct. 23, 1943. On Nov. 10 the outfit was officially attached to Acorn 22 at Hueneme. The first echelon traveled to Oakland, Calif., and embarked Nov. 22. On the same date the second echelon embarked at Hueneme. Both sections arrived at Pearl Harbor Dec. 1, 1943. The two echelons embarked at Iroquois Point, Oahu Feb. 10 and 12, 1944, and landed at Eniwetok on Feb. 22 and 24. Sailing westward again, this time in five echelons, the men went ashore at Tinian on Sept. 9 and 18, and Oct. 1, 9 and 20, 1944. At the end of the war, the outfit was still on Tinian.

ITINERARY OF THE 110TH U. S. NAVAL CONSTRUCTION BATTALION.

- 31 July 1943 - Formed at NCTC, Camp Peary, Williamsburg, Va.
- 12 Aug 1943 - Formal Commissioning at NCTC, Williamsburg, Va.
- 8 & 9 Sept 1943 - Departed NCTC, Camp Peary, Va. in three (3) Echelons of approximately (370) men each.
- 10 & 11 Sept 1943 - Arrived AFD, Gulfport, Miss. (Three Echelons)
- 13 Oct 1943 - Departed AFD, Gulfport, Miss, in three (3) Echelons of approximately (370) men each.
- 23 Oct 1943 - Arrived Fort Huachuca, (Camp Rousseau), California. (Three Echelons)
- 10 Nov 1943 - Formal Commissioning with Acorn 23, Splinter City, Camp Rousseau, California.
- 20 Nov 1943 - 1st Echelon, (Approx. 450 men), departed from Camp Rousseau, Calif., arriving at Oakland, Calif., 31 Nov 1943, boarded ship on this date and sailed to meet convoy for overseas on 02 Nov 1943.
- 22 Nov 1943 - 2nd Echelon, (Approx. 650 men), departed Camp Rousseau, Calif. for overseas.
- 1 Dec 1943 - Both Echelons arrived Pearl Harbor, AFBD, Iroquois Point, Hawaii.
- 10 Feb 1944 - 1st Echelon, (Approx. 600 men), departed AFBD, Iroquois Point, P. H.
- 12 Feb 1944 - 2nd Echelon, (Approx. 500 men), departed AFBD, Iroquois Point, P. H.
- 20 Feb. 1944 - 2nd Echelon, arrived Eniwetok Atoll, Marshall Islands, (went ashore on 22 Feb 1944)
- 23 Feb 1944 - 1st Echelon, arrived Eniwetok Atoll, Marshall Islands, (went ashore on 24 Feb 1944).
- 24 Aug 1944 - 1st Echelon, (Approx. 270 men), departed Eniwetok.
- 29 Aug 1944 - 1st Echelon arrived Saipan, Marianas Islands.
- 9 Sept 1944 - 1st Echelon, (Approx. 270 men), moved to Tinian, Marianas Islands.
- 13 Sept 1944 - 2nd Echelon, (Approx. 290 men), departed Eniwetok.
- 18 Sept 1944 - 2nd Echelon arrived Tinian, Marianas Islands.
