The **Cold War Sea Bag** contains Cold War Navy-related artifacts, and focuses on the Vietnam War. Additionally, the sea bag includes oral histories from local Vietnam veterans. Both traveling trunks contain detailed guides to using the artifacts and materials in the classroom setting.
