

Volunteer Job Description

Position: Gallery Attendant

Supervisor: Navy Museums Northwest Volunteer Coordinators and Staff.

Objective: To promote awareness of the United States Navy – its history, mission, and presence in the Pacific Northwest – to the general public.

Responsibilities:

- Be a visible presence in the museum's galleries
- Provide opportunities for informal conversations with visitor about topics related to the museums' exhibits and the United States Navy
- Assist with guided tours as needed
- Monitor exhibits and artifacts on display and report any damage to museum staff

Qualifications:

- Interest in any of the following: the US Navy, naval history, maritime history, marine science, engineering, etc.
- Interest in meeting and talking with the public
- Friendly and enthusiastic
- Willing to work as a member of a team
- Willingness to commit to a specific shift
- Ability to move throughout the museum

Training: NMNW staff will provide general orientation and any content specific training needed.

Requirements:

- Attend training
- Pass a basic background check
- Commit to a minimum of one 3 hour shift per week for at least 6 months
