# **Post – Visit Crossword Puzzle**

**Overview:** Assign students to complete the crossword puzzle of vocabulary words. The words learned in this activity were used extensively throughout the Puget Sound Navy Museum.

Grade Level: 1-4

**Essential Questions:** What do these key vocabulary words mean? What tools did you need to use to find the meaning of these words?




