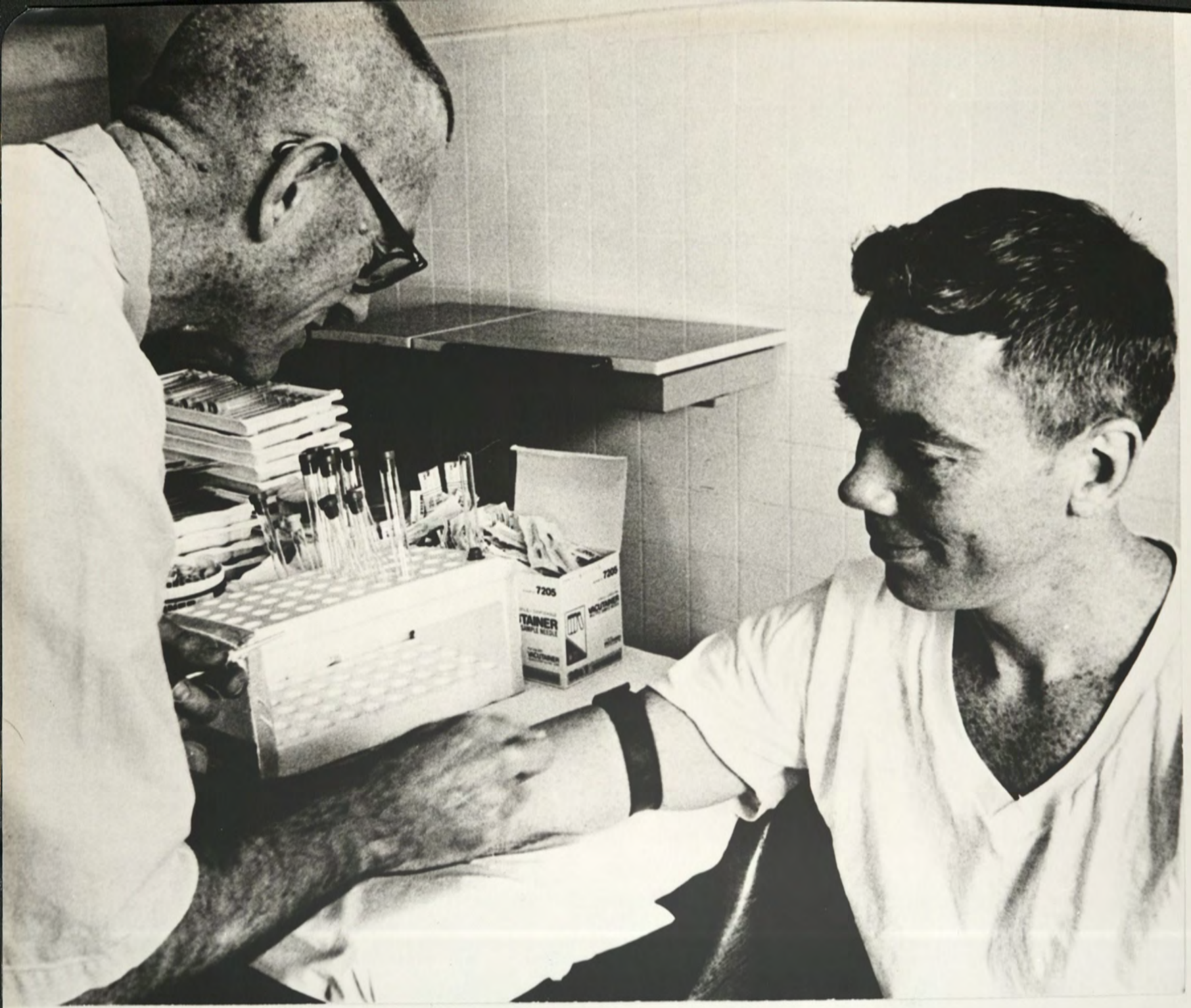


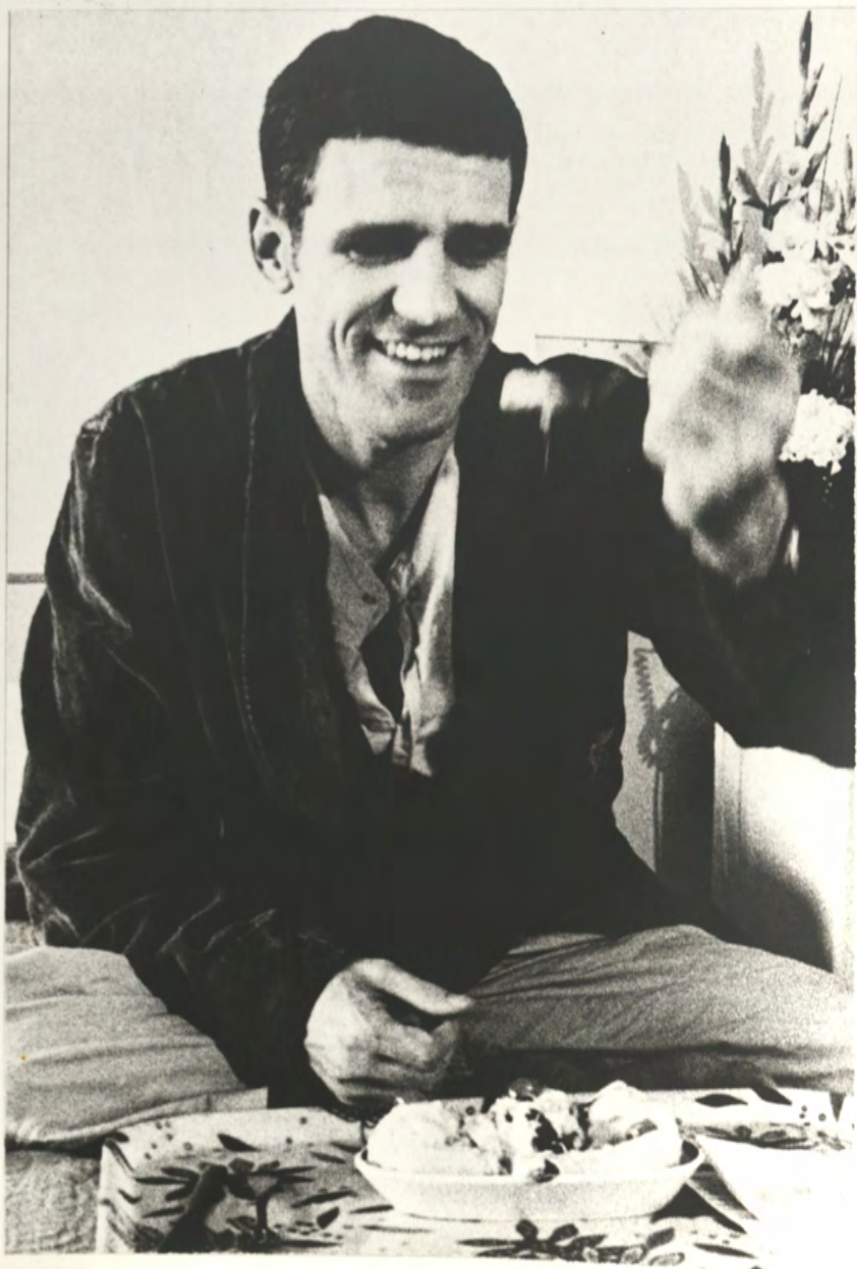
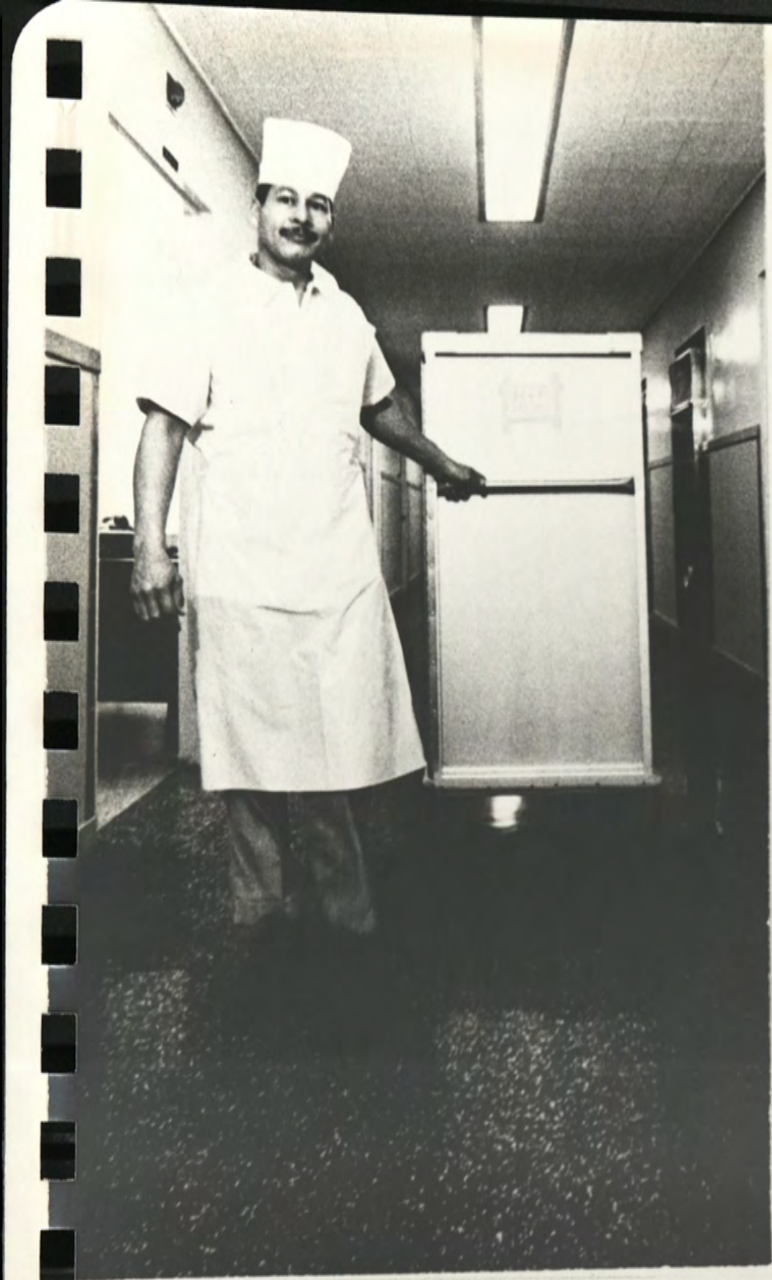


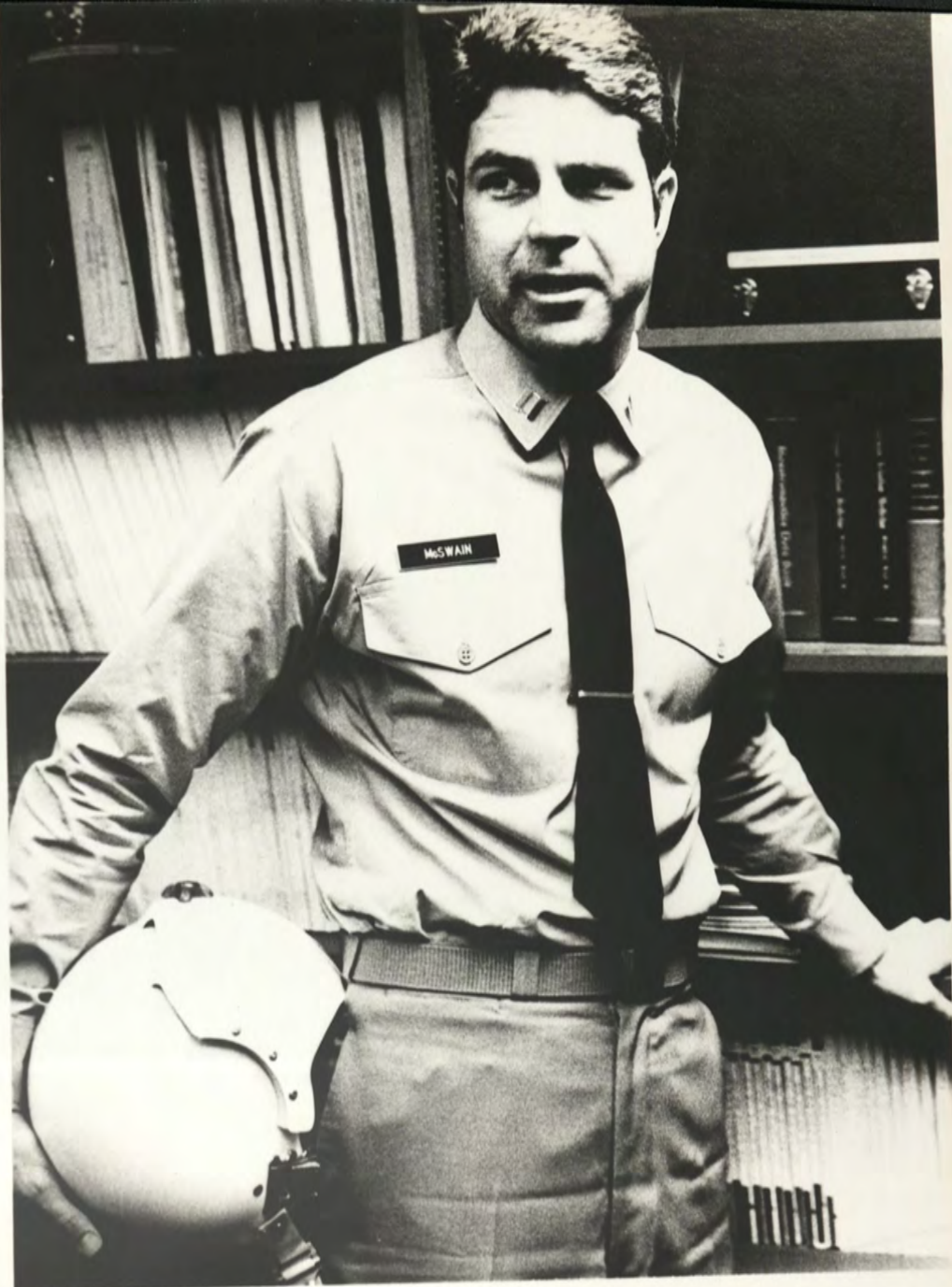


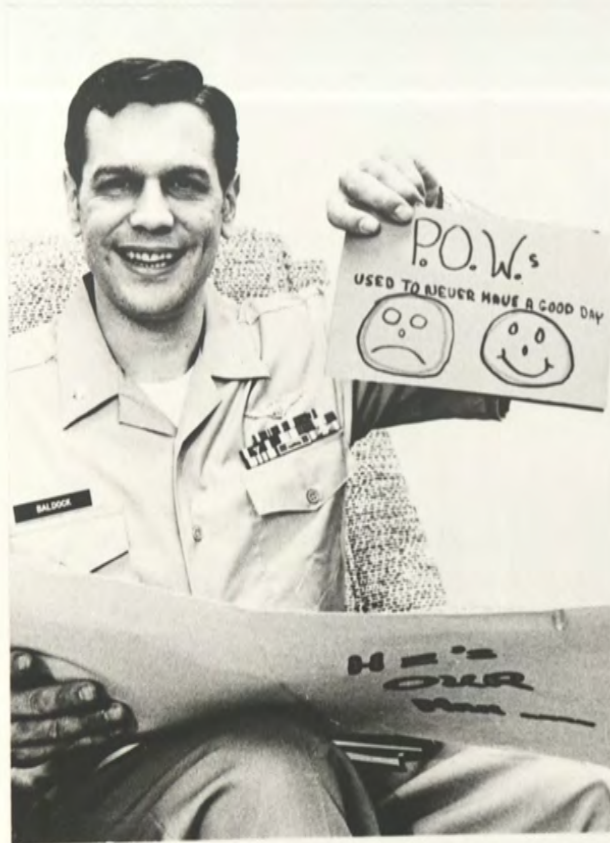












Lt. Cmdr. Frederick C. BALDOCK, Jr., USNR

Cmdr. Cole BLACK, USN

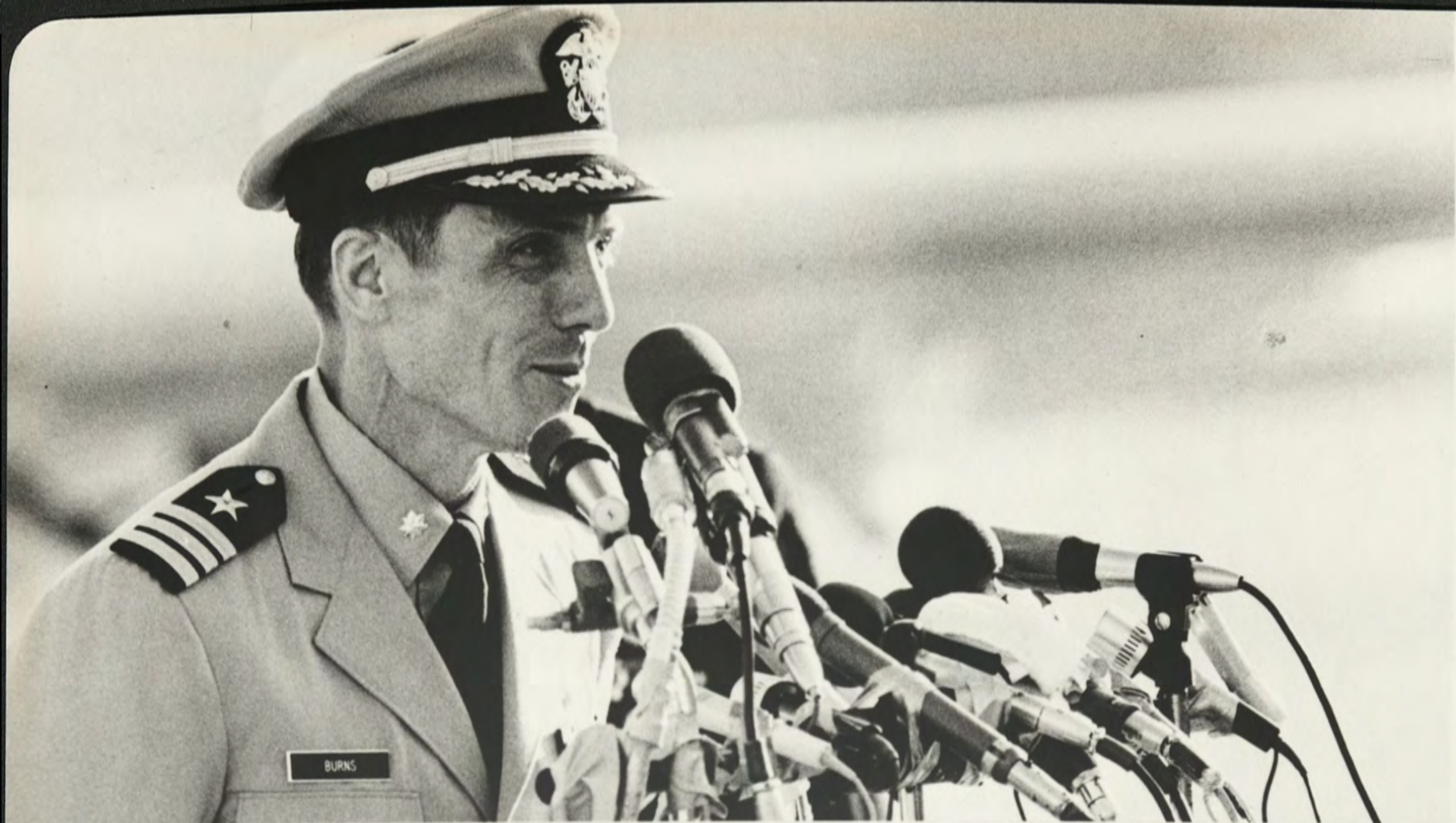

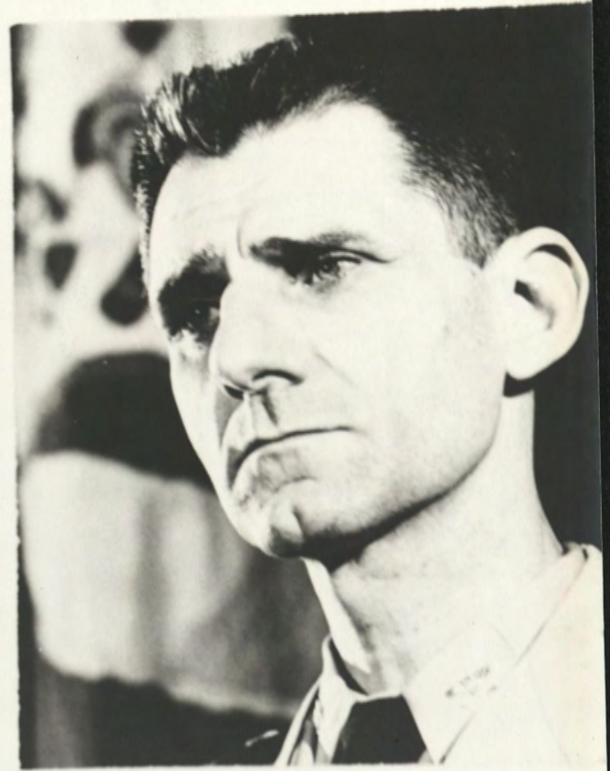




Capt. Harry T. JENKINS, Jr., USN
