




1700s



1779 SEPTEMBER 23

Under command of Capt. John Paul Jones, the crew of **Bonhomme Richard** defeats the much more heavily armed HMS Serapis in a brutal fight, taking their opponent's ship as a prize.

1797 OCTOBER 21

With Capt. Samuel Nicholson in command, USS **Constitution** is launched in Boston, Mass. Undefeated in battle and still in service today, she is the world's oldest commissioned warship afloat.

1804 FEBRUARY 16

Lt. Stephen Decatur leads a small band of American Sailors into Tripoli Harbor and burns the captured frigate Philadelphia without the loss of life.




862 MARCH 9

1942 JUNE 4-7

With superior communications intelligence, Pacific Fleet Sailors and Marines ambush the Japanese fleet at Midway. The decisive victory costs Japan four aircraft carriers and its strategic advantage in WWII.
