MARCH 19

In an effort to liberate the Iraqi people and end the regime of Saddam Hussein, Operation Iraqi Freedom begins with airstrikes.

JANUARY 12

A magnitude seven earthquake hits Haiti. The U.S. Navy is a key contributor to Operation Unified Response, providing water, food, and medical supplies.



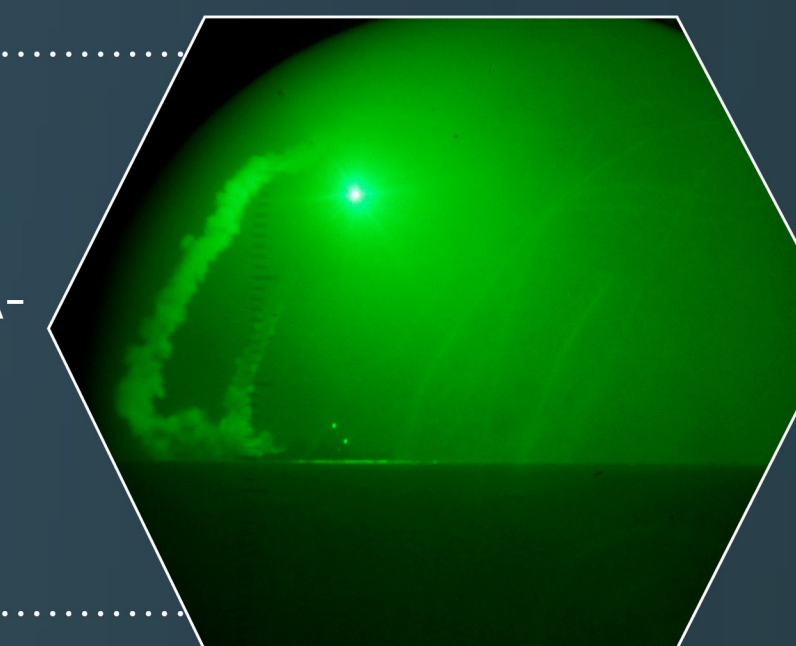

Four Norfolk ships deploy to support relief operations on the Gulf Coast in the wake of Hurrigan Katrina, which made landfall Aug. 29.

MARCH 19

Operation Odyssey Dawn begins with strikes on Libya. This is the first use of SSGN-launched TLAMs in combat, first EA-18G action against hostile forces, and the first time Maverick missiles are fired by a P-3C on a hostile vessel.

JULY 16

The Iwo Jima ESG and embarked 24th MEU are ordered to Lebanon to evacuate Americans from the war torn country.

MAY 1

Navy SEALs kill al-Qaeda leader Osama bin Laden in an intelligence-driven U.S. operation in Pakistan.



2008
FEBRUARY 20

USS Lake Erie (CG 70) fires a Standard Missile-3, destroying a dangerous, non-functioning satellite just before it enters earth's atmosphere.



2014
SEPTEMBER 23

USS Arleigh Burke (DDG 51) and USS Philippine Sea (CG 58) launch 47 Tomahawk strikes against ISIL targets.
