HSL-45 COMMAND HISTORY

A. COMMAND COMPOSITION AND ORGANIZATION

MISSION

The primary mission of HSL-45 is to provide fully mission capable LAMPS MK III detachments for deployment aboard cruisers, destroyers and frigates assigned to the U.S. Pacific Fleet. The helicopters assigned to these detachments are an integral part of the ship's weapons systems, extending the ship's anti-submarine warfare and anti-ship surveillance and targeting capabilities beyond the horizon. Secondary missions of these detachments include search and rescue, medical evacuation, vertical replenishment and communications relay.
