2. Summary of Operations.


a. 1981 Chronology

January

- Fleet indoctrination presentation, flight familiarization and static display at VT-10, NAS Pensacola, Fl.
- 13-15 Deployed one aircraft to NAS Lemoore in support of CVW-9 Mini-Alpha Strikes.
- The squadron coordinated Orange Force raid aircraft and provided a White (umpire) E-2 for READIEX 2-81.
- Provided range clearance, communication relay and Link 4 vectoring for a successful HARPOON missile test conducted by PMTC Pt. Mugu.
- 27-29 Deployed one aircraft to NAS Lemoore in support of CVW-9 Mini-Alpha Strikes.

February

1-28 Conducted operational flights, with emphasis on day/night FCLP's for pilot qualification.





February

- 9 A qualified Mission Commander embarked in USS WADDELL to act as observer for CVW-9 WASEX against COMCRUDESGRU ONE units.
- 19 Provided Command and Control for fighters and adversaries in TOPGUN 1-81 GRADEX operations.
- 20 Coordinated Orange Force raid aircraft and provided a White (umpire) E-2 for READIEX 3-81.
- 21 Fleet indoctrination presentation and static display at Lowery AFB, Co.
- 25 Coordinated Orange Force raid aircraft and provided a White (umpire) E-2 for READIEX 3-81.
- 27-28 Provided Link 11 services and conducted deck certification flights aboard USS CONSTELLATION (CV-64).

March

- 1-2 Provided Link services and conducted deck certification flights aboard USS CONSTELLATION (CV-64).
- 2-12 Conducted operational flights with emphasis on day/night FCLP's for pilot qualification.
- 12-17 Provided Link 11 services and conducted carrier qualification/ACLS certification flights aboard USS CONSTELLATION (CV-64).
- Coordinated Orange Force raid aircraft for 17 READIEX 4-81.
- Provided Link 11 services for a successful 18-20 over-the-horizon test of the TOMAHAWK cruise missile.
- 24-27 The squadron provided support for VF-24 TAP exercises and received training in small scale ECM.
- Embarked in USS CONSTELLATION for REFTRA in the 27 Southern California (SOCAL) OPAREA.

April

Embarked in USS CONSTELLATION for REFTRA in SOCAL 1-10 DECLASSIFIED OPAREA.

- 13-16 Embarked in USS CONSTELLATION for AIROPS in the SOCAL OPAREA and completed REFTRA exercises.
- 21-24 Conducted HRAV workshops.
- 30 Embarked in USS CONSTELLATION for AIROPS in the SOCAL OPAREA.

May

- 1-13 Embarked in USS CONSTELLATION for cyclic operations in the SOCAL OPAREA.
- 15 Squadron members and their dependents participated in a dependent's day cruise aboard USS CONSTELLATION.
- 24-31 Deployed to NAS Fallon, Nv. in support of CVW-9 Weapons Training Exercises.

June

- 1-2 Deployed to NAS Fallon, Nv.
- 3-9 The squadron conducted routine operational flights at NAS Miramar.
- 10-21 Embarked in USS CONSTELLATION to participate in a COMPTUEX in the SOCAL OPAREA.

July

- 1-6 Conducted FCLP flights at NAS Miramar.
- CDR F. A. Miley relieved CDR T. E. Morgan as Commanding Officer of VAW-112
- 3 Surpassed eight years of Accident Free Flying
- 7-21 Embarked in USS CONSTELLATION to participate in FLEETEX 1-81 in the SOCAL OPAREA.
- 22-28 Conducted blue water operations in USS CONSTELLATION while transiting to Hawaii. Operations included COMPEX/TRAEX evaluations in A-2-CC and A-3-CI exercises.

July

27-28 Controlled EMCON launch/recoveries and long range strikes on Kahoolawe Island and Kaula Rock in the Hawaiian OPAREA.

August

- 1-7 Embarked in USS CONSTELLATION for TRANSITEX 15B-81 from Hawaii to San Diego.
- 8-31 Inport at NAS Miramar. Three aircraft incorporated AFC 290 modifying the Link 11 system to include NCS capability.
- 19-20 Provided two aircraft for a CVW-9 airshow demonstration aboard USS CONSTELLATION in honor of President Reagan.
- 21-31 Conducted operational flights emphasizing FCLP's.

September

- Supported VF-24/211 in graded exercises against TOPGUN.
- 2-10 Flew FCLP's in preparation for refresher operations in USS CONSTELLATION.
- 11-16 Embarked in USS CONSTELLATION for READIEX 6-81.
- 17-20 Participated in an Operational Readiness Evaluation (ORE).
- 21-30 Completed annual NATOPS unit evaluation, pilot instrument checks and evaluation of the NCS modification installed in squadron aircraft.

October

- 1-16 No operational flights were conducted.
- 17-20 The squadron embarked in USS CONSTELLATION.
- 20 USS CONSTELLATION and CVW-9 underway for Western Pacific/Indian Ocean deployment.
- 20-25 Conducted operational flights in support of TRANSITEX 2-82.





October

25-30 Participated in three KOMAREX'S, two MISSILEX'S, two ALPHA Strikes and a night Vector Logic exercise in the Hawaiian OPAREA.

November

- 3-24 Conducted cyclic operations and provided real-world AEW/BEAR escort coordination during TRANSITEX 2-82.
- 25-30 Inport Subic Bay, Republic of the Philippines.

December

- 1-4 Inport Subic Bay. The squadron flew FCLP's and one familarization flight for the prospective CO of USS TRUXTON (CGN-35).
- 5-8 A MISSILEX, SINKEX and several WASEX'S were conducted in the Philippine OPAREA as part of refresher ops. The squadron provided airborne early warning and CAP escort coordination.
- 9-13 USS CONSTELLATION transited the South China Sea and Straits of Malacca.
- 1.0 Two Soviet BEAR aircraft detected by airborne E-2C and intercepted/escorted by CAP under their control.
- Provided Airborne Early Warning and Strike Control in CV ADEX against USS CORAL SEA (CV-43)
- 18-23 Cyclic operations conducted in the vicinity of Diego Garcia.
- 26-31 The squadron flew operational flights in the Arabian Sea.
- 29 Two IL-38 May aircraft were detected and escorted under E-2 control.
