VAW-77 Command History

1. Command Composition and Organization Airborne Early Warning Squadron SEVEN SEVEN's (VAW-77) primary mission is to serve as a counter-drug command and control asset in our nation's war on drugs. VAW-77 is a Naval Reserve Squadron based at NAS Atlanta, Georgia, flying four Northrop Grumman E-2C Hawkeye aircraft. The command falls under the administrative control of Carrier Air Wing Reserve TWO ZERO while based at NAS Atlanta, GA, and under the operational control of Commander, Task Force FOUR ZERO while deployed. The squadron's operational commitment was 120 days per year until recently, when it was increased to a 150 day annual requirement. The area of operations while deployed has been the Caribbean. Tasking comes from Director, Joint Interagency Task Force EAST via the Tactical Support Center at Naval Station Roosevelt Roads. Squadron manning is composed of eighteen full time Training and Administration of the Reserves (TAR) officers, nineteen enlisted, twenty-six Selected Reserve Officers and ten enlisted. Maintenance on the aircraft is provided by thirty-nine Northrop Grumman contractor personnel.

- (7) 29 November 00 - 01 December, Detachment in support of Space Shuttle Operations, Patrick AFB, Florida.
- (8) 05-06 December 00 - Link exercise with USS Iwo Jima, NAS Pensacola, Florida.

3. Narrative

VAW-77 provided support to Operations Bahamas Turks flying 6 sorties for a total of 34 hours. The squadron was called to provide Command and Control for CVW-14's deployment to NAS Fallon, flying 3 sorties for 25.2 hours. On two separate occasions, VAW-77 provided flights supporting Space Shuttle Operations out of Patrick AFB.

VAW-77 was awarded the Joint Meritorious Unit Award for calendar year 1997 and the Meritorious Unit Commendation for the period of 01 October 1995 to 28 May 1998. The squadron was also awarded the Battle "E" for calendar year 1998. To date VAW-77 has flown 7566.4 hours and 1982 sorties in support of Counter-Drug operations. The squadron has been directly responsible for the seizure of 28 metric tons of cocaine and 11.5 metric tons of marijuana enroute to the United States.

1. Per reference (a), enclosure (1) is submitted.
2. The year 2000 saw the Nightwolves continue to operate among the top tier of DOD assets dedicated to our nation's war on drugs. Breaking new ground, VAW-77 successfully completed its first 75-day counter narcotics deployment and flew an unprecedented number of hours, while enduring its lowest FTS pilot manning (five) since the squadron's inception. All flight operations were conducted mishap-free despite a demanding optempo/perstempo.
3. Additionally, VAW-77 flew multiple AIC missions with Air Force, Air National Guard, Marine, and Navy fighter assets, emphasizing current joint tactics and procedures in preparation for CVW-20 Air Wing detachment to Fallon, NV.
