

- a. During Fiscal Year 1977, VC-6 launched a total of 321 MQM-74C and 30 KD2R-5 Aerial Drone Targets, setting an all-time record for the squadron and the Navy.
- b. On 6 April 1977, LT first employed the over the horizon hand-off control technique which was developed to extend the effective range of MQM-74C operations.
- c. 14 May 1977 the squadron's call sign was officially changed, enclosure (6).
- d. 1977 was the first year of operations using the new insignia (approved 26 November 1976) enclosure (7).
- e. 9 July 1977, VC-6 participated in its first Open Ocean Missilex with the SIXTH Fleet, launching eight MQM-74C Aerial Targets.
- f. LT launched and controlled the last VC-6 KD2R-5 Aerial Target Drone from USS MILWAUKEE on July 1977 while returning from Operation Silver Jubilee.
