

1979 COMMAND HISTORY NARRATIVE

The Fighting Diamondbacks of Fighter Squadron ONE HUNDRED TWO commanded by Commander W. J. DENNING commenced 1979 by sending two crews, Aircraft and support personnel to the Naval Fighter Weapons School (TopGun) at NAS Miramar, California from 6 Jan to 16 Feb. The squadron deployed on-board USS INDEPENDENCE (CV-62) for Type Training ORE and Refreshment Training (TYT I and REFTRA) from 12 to 23 February off the Virginia Capes. Between 2 March and 14 April, the squadron again deployed for Type Training Two, Three, and the Operational Readiness Evaluation (TYT II, III, and ORE). Ports visited during this period were Fort Lauderdale, Florida and ST. THOMAS, Virgin Islands. Shortly following ORE, the squadron participated in "Solid Shield '79" off the coast of the Virginia Capes. This lasted from 9 May to 22 May. The squadron again commenced Refreshment Training from 19 to 22 June. Finally on 28 June, Fighter Squadron ONE HUNDRED TWO embarked again on the USS INDEPENDENCE (CV-62) commencing their eighteenth Mediterranean Cruise that lasted until 14 December. The ports visited during the cruise included Naples, Italy; Rota, Spain; Toulon, France; Athens, Greece; Haifa, Israel, Palermo, Sicily; Palma, Spain; and Genoa, Italy.
