During the period 28 March through 2 December, Fighter Squadron TWO was heavily involved in predeployment preparations. During this period the major areas of emphasis were air combat maneuvering, air intercept training, missile exercises and air to air gunnery. Some of the aircrews qualified for the battle "E" for their work with the AIM-7 Sparrow missile, AIM-9 Sidewinder missile, and air to air gunnery. While on deployment to MCAS Yuma, Arizona, during early August, VF-2 competed in an Air Combat Exercise in which 100 percent of the aircrews that participated in the exercise received the battle "E" for ACM.

In December carrier qualification aboard the USS ENTERPRISE began. Nine new nuggets began the qualification phase with VF-2 and all Bounty Hunters qualified new and old alike. The remainder of December found VF-2 planning ahead for the up coming WESTPAC cruise.

C. SPECIAL TOPICS

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS - 1977

- 1. Fighter Squadron TWO aircrews received a total of 47 battle "E" certificates over the months of August, September, October, and November 1977.
- 2. On 16 February 1977 Fighter Squadron TWO was the first squadron to intercept the Russian IL-38 "MAY" ASW aircraft while deployed in the Indian Ocean.
