# 1987 Command History for VC-12

Fleet Composite Squadron TWELVE (VC-12) is assigned to the Commander, Fleet Logistics Support Wing (COMFLELOGSUPPWING) with the mission to train Naval Reservists for possible mobilization while simultaneously providing aircraft services in support of operational training of Regular and Reserve units of the Navy and other Armed Services. These aircraft services include: Adversary, Air Combat Maneuvering, Dissimilar Air Combat Training, Air Intercept Training, Air Search and Fire Control Radar Tracking, Aerial Target Towing and Inflight Refueling. Fleet Composite Squadron TWELVE performs these services with 7 TA-4J, 5 A4-E, 2 A4-F aircraft. Operations are conducted from NAS Oceana with frequent squadron detachments to numerous locations.

Completed a 9 day detachment at NAS Fallon, NV. Four aircraft provided Carrier Air Wing Reserve TWENTY (CVWR-20) with 77 sorties for a total of 129.1 flight hours. The mission included DACT and STRIKE OPPOSITION. The total mission hours were 72.6 and the total transit hours were 56.5. Support personnel included 7 officer and 14 enlisted.

## FEBRUARY 1987

7 - 21

Completed a 15 day detachment to NAS Fallon, NV. Five aircraft provided Strike Fighter Squadron ONE ZERO SIX (VFA-106) with 146 sorties for a total of 221.1 flight hours. The mission was DACT. The total mission hours were 124.0 and the total transit hours were 97.1. Support personnel included 11 officers and 13 enlisted.

#### MARCH 1987
