## BASIC HISTORY

Nineteen Hundred Seventy Six saw the celebration of our Nation's 200th Birthday. The completion of our Bicentennial year also saw Fleet Logistics Support Squadron FORTY (VRC-40) surpass eight years and over 41,000 hours of accident-free flying. This achievement came while VRC-40 continued its outstanding service and support of the Atlantic Fleet. This outstanding safety record, coupled with an enviable record for mission accomplishment is indicative of the 100% plus dedication of every member of VRC-40 to the achievement of SERVICE with SAFETY.

VRC-40 is tasked with the mission of Carrier Onboard Delivery to the aircraft carriers of the Atlantic Fleet. In addition to operating from various eastern and Gulf Coast Naval Air Stations, VRC-40 also operates detachments out of Roosevelt Roads, Puerto Rico and Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. Safely transporting numerous passengers, mail, and high priority cargo in the aging C-1A aircraft accentuates the significance of the outstanding safety record which VRC-40 has compiled.

Commander James E. Roth served as Commanding Officer of VRC-40 until 6 August 1976, when he was relieved by Commander Grady W. Davis. Commander Fleet Tactical Support Wing ONE, VRC-40's reporting senior, is Captain Gerard R. Olson.

1976 was a rewarding year for VRC-40. During the year VRC-40 supported all eight Atlantic Fleet carriers while operating out of six different bases. In addition, VRC-40 crews and aircraft were employed in the training of U.S. Navy SEAL teams and U.S. Marine Corps Parachutists. VRC-40 also provided COD services to CINCLANT's "Exercise Solid Shield 76" and the NATO "Reforger" exercises.

With the close of 1976, VRC-40 had transported to the Fleet over 180,000 pounds of mail and cargo and more than 3,300 passengers while safely accumulating 1,063 arrested landings.
