#### VRC-40 1998 COMMAND HISTORY

#### 1. Command Composition and Organization.

- a. Fleet Logistics Support Squadron FOUR ZERO (VRC-40) is assigned the joint tasks of Carrier Onboard Delivery (COD) and Naval Special Warfare Support Services to the Navy's SECOND, FIFTH and SIXTH Fleets. VRC-40 performs these missions in the Grumman C-2A "Greyhound" Aircraft.
- b. The Grumman C-2A carries the largest cargo pay-load of any fixed wing carrier aircraft and is the mainstay of the Carrier Battle Group logistics support effort. The optimum fuel efficiency and cruising speeds of the C-2A enable the VRC-40 "Rawhides" to provide service to Carrier Battle Groups throughout the vast SECOND, FIFTH and SIXTH Fleet operating areas. Unlike most Fleet squadrons, VRC-40 does not deploy as a unit; instead, a two-plane, self-sustaining detachment is assigned to each deploying carrier battle group. The detachment operates while embarked on board the aircraft carrier or from forward land-based sites, providing the most flexible and expeditious delivery of high-priority personnel, cargo and mail. Additionally, VRC-40 deploys detachments in support of routine SECOND Fleet carrier exercises as required.
- c. Naval Station, Norfolk, Virginia is the homeport of VRC-40.
- d. VRC-40's Immediate Senior in Command is Commander, Airborne Early Warning Wing, U.S. Atlantic Fleet (COMAEWWINGLANT), also located at Naval Station, Norfolk, Virginia.
- e. VRC-40's Commanding Officer from 1 January to 31 December 1998 is Commander Mark R. Boettcher.

#### 3. Narrative.

a. The VRC-40 "Rawhides" have completed another great year of service to the U.S. Atlantic Fleet, with a 15 year perfect safety record. This is an impressive record for a squadron that supports no fewer than six Aircraft Carriers at sea. VRC-40 has sent four detachments on deployment this year in support of USS GEORGE WASHINGTON (CVN 73), USS JOHN C. STENNIS (CVN 74), USS DWIGHT D. EISENHOWER (CVN 69), and still at sea with USS ENTERPRISE (CVN 65). Additionally, the "Rawhides" sent detachments to Puerto Rico.

b. Public relations are very important to the men and women of VRC-40. The Distinguished Visitor Program has enabled many high level and influential people to visit Aircraft Carriers at sea.

The "Honorary Tailhooker" Program has been a great experience for all who fly with the "Rawhides". The "Rawhides" have also attended numerous airshows across the country in an effort to promote Carrier Onboard Delivery (COD). The following list shows some of VRC-40's COD statistics:

Total Passengers carried: 21,790

Cargo carried: 2,133,865 lbs.

Mail carried: 881,569 lbs.

Sorties: 1,537

Flight hours: 4698.3 hrs.

Carrier arrested landings: 1,185

Despite significant manning shortfalls and challenging operational commitments, VRC-40 has been able to support the Atlantic Fleet in virtually all tasking. While pilot shortages remain an ongoing factor, the "Rawhides" will get the job done.
