3. Narrative.

ALBUQUERQUE entered 1995 on deployment in the Western Atlantic tasked with a mission of vital importance to National Security. Following this highly praised mission ALBUQUERQUE participated in operation STRONG RESOLVE; a major NATO exercise involving many different NATO countries and their Naval Forces. Upon return to port the ALBUQUERQUE crew enjoyed a brief stand down period during which CDR Michael R. King USN was relieved, after a highly successful command tour, by CDR Leonard A. Zingarelli USN. An intensive post deployment upkeep followed which enabled the ship to complete all needed repairs. The ALBUQUERQUE began the summer participating in torpedo proficiency exercises and certifications which enabled her to demonstrate her tactical prowess. These operations included support for an SSBN and an SSN during their Tactical Readiness Examinations in the AUTEC operation areas. These operations resulted in the need to enter the USS SHIPPINGPORT (ARDM-4) for emergent repairs to the towed array sonar system. The ship exited ARDM-4 rapidly allowing for extensive preparations for an Operational Reactor Safeguards Examination in early November. ALBUQUERQUE then entered a Pre Overseas Movement cycle to prepare for another mission of vital importance to National Security in spring of 1996.
