1. The following command history of USS ALEXANDRIA (SSN 757) is submitted in accordance with reference (a). The following history covers the period from January 1994 through December 1994.

2. Command composition and organization

Mission: To support the objectives of National defense policy in support of the U. S Atlantic Fleet by all possible means, including locating and destroying submarines and surface ships, conducting reconnaissance, strike warfare, mine planting, and operations with special warfare units.

Organizational structure: An element of Submarine Development Squadron TWELVE. Main operational departments are Engineering, Navigation/Operations, Combat Systems and Supply.



3. Narrative. Upon completion of Deployment to the Mediterranean Sea, for which ALEXANDRIA was awarded the Sharp Shooter Award for overall strike warfare proficiency, several examinations and inspections of the ship were conducted, including an Operational Reactor Safeguards Examination (ORSE), Tactical Readiness Examination (TRE), Logistics Readiness Evaluation (LRE), and Battlegroup Exercises. Among the VIP's visiting was the Honorable John H. Dalton, Secretary of the Navy. Following one stop in port Everglades, Florida, the Ship conducted a Tiger cruise for several family members of the crew.

The ship returned from deployment as part of the USS AMERICA Battlegroup in February. Ports-of-call included La Madalena, Italy and Gibraltar. Following Stand down, the ship conducted several upkeeps and conducted a port visit in Pascagoula, MS. ALEXANDRIA was awarded the Battle Efficiency "E", the Communications "C", and the Supply "E" from Submarine Development Squadron Twelve for 1994.
