Narrative. ALEXANDRIA began 1997 drydocked in ARDM-4 SHIPPINGPORT in Groton, CT. Several upkeep periods and a second drydocking were accomplished in 1997, including the Pre-Overseas Movement (POM) upkeep leading to deployment. Upon completion of deployed operations in the Atlantic in November, ALEXANDRIA received the Arctic Service Ribbon. The ship conducted a Change of Command ceremony prior to the Christmas standdown period. During the year, several distinguished quest toured the ALEXANDRIA, including U.S. Senator Lieberman, Ambassador Blinken, and numerous senior dignitaries of the Belgian government and military.
