4. Narrative.

a. 1996 was a banner year for USS ASHEVILLE. ASHEVILLE set the standard for other SSNs to follow in Shallow Water Operations. Significant accomplishments included the first deployment of the new Advanced Mine Detection Sonar (AMDS) System.

b. ASHEVILLE has 14 officers and 126 enlisted personnel. Major objectives of the command during the past year have been:

(1) Operational evaluation of the first submarine force installation of AMDS.

(2) Successful Western Pacific deployment.

(3) Continued emphasis on strike warfare.

(4) Demonstrated submarine ability to conduct extended shallow water operations.

(5) Successful completion of Northrop Grumman Sea Ferret Operational Demonstration.
