### C. Narrative

<u>January</u>. The ship returned from a Mediterranean deployment in mid-December, 2000. The crew celebrated the holidays with their families during most of the month of January. The remainder of the month was spent inport Norfolk Naval Station reacquainting the crew with the normal inport routine.

<u>February</u>. AUSTIN was away from homeport for most of February. She departed Norfolk 12 February and arrived Key West Florida for a brief port visit. The crew enjoyed the warm weather, but were anxious for their next port visit in New Orleans. AUSTIN arrived in time for Mardi Gras, 21 February and remained in New

Orleans until 28 February 2001. Duty sections conducted various ship tours while inport and the crew enjoyed the parties and parades of the Mardi Gras celebration.

<u>March</u>. AUSTIN got underway again on 1 March 2001 and returned to Key West for storm evasion and two additional days of liberty. The ship returned to Norfolk 9 March 2001. The prospective Commanding Officer, CDR Colonna, arrived to the ship on 13 March 2001. The ship's 36<sup>th</sup> birthday party was held at the Surfside Inn in Virginia Beach, on 15 March 2001. CDR Colonna assumed command on 22 March 2001.

<u>April</u>. The AUSTIN got underway frequently for training purposes during April. The crew proved their expertise to the Commanding Officer during various evolutions such as; Basic Engineering Casualty Control Exercises (BECCE's), Main Space Fire Drills, Flight Quarters, Close-In/Weapons System (CIWS) PACFIRE, ULM-4 Range, anchoring evolutions and small boat operations.

May. AUSTIN remained inport until mid-May when she got underway to conduct a Burial at Sea. AUSTIN arrived in Mayport, FL 16 May for a port visit and returned to homeport on 21 May 2001.

June. AUSTIN remained inport until 11 June 2001 when she arrived at the Yorktown Naval Weapons Station for the ammunition offload. AUSTIN returned to Norfolk 15 June 2001 and conducted a Family Day Cruise on her transit from Yorktown. Friends and family were able to ride the ship and see what a typical day is like on AUSTIN. To celebrate, the ship hosted a steel beach picnic on the flight deck. AUSTIN departed Norfolk again 25 June 2001 and arrived Metro Machine Imperial Docking Company the same day, where she would remain for approximately three months for a Phased Maintenance Availability.

<u>July</u>. The crew and shipyard workers were busy with repairs this month during AUSTIN's post-deployment maintenance availability at Metro Machine.

<u>August</u>. The crew and shipyard workers were busy with repairs this month during AUSTIN's post-deployment maintenance availability at Metro Machine.

<u>September</u>. The crew and shipyard workers were busy with repairs during AUSTIN'S post-deployment maintenance availability. On September 11<sup>th</sup> AUSTIN set Threatcon "D" in response to the attacks on the World Trade Center and the Pentagon. All work was ceased by Metro Machine. On 14 September 2001, the newly inducted Chief Petty Officers were pinned during a small ceremony held at Metro Machine with their friends and family.

AUSTIN also held a prayer service on 14 September 2001 in remembrance of the victims of the September 11<sup>th</sup> attacks. AUSTIN's crew sailed successfully through a Light Off Assessment (LOA) on 24 September 2001.

October. AUSTIN's Aviation Certification (AVCERT) was successfully conducted 1-3 October. The ship finally finished the yard period and departed Metro Machine 9 October 2001. AUSTIN remained at sea for two days and conducted a Burial at Sea while underway. AUSTIN got underway again 15 October 2001 and conducted various training exercises including; Flight Quarters, Small Boat Operations, Engineering Drills, M-14, 9mm familiarization fire, underway replenishment with USNS Patuxent, anti-terrorism training for all hands, TACAN Range, chemical, biological, radiological general quarters drill, and a detect to engage exercise. AUSTIN returned to Norfolk Naval Station 23 October 2001.

November. AUSTIN conducted the CART II inspection 5-9 November and returned to sea 13 November 2001. She remained at sea conducting various engineering evolutions, swing ship and Landing Craft Air Cushion (LCAC) Operations. AUSTIN returned to homeport 20 November 2001 in time for the crew to be with their families for the Thanksgiving holiday.

<u>December</u>. AUSTIN conducted her pre-Insurv inspection during the first part of the month. This year's Christmas party was held at the Surfside Inn in Virginia Beach. The crew enjoyed the remainder of December celebrating the holidays with their families and friends.
