# **USS AVENGER (MCM-1)**

## <u>Narrative</u>

1. GOMEX 97-1: Participated in MCMEX. The exercised was used to prepare for the Euro-97 deployment.

2. Euro-97 deployment: Avenger performed adroitly throughout the deployment. The following items are the most notable:

A. VEMS trials-Avenger was selected to participate in VEMS (practice mines) trials off the coast of Florida prior to the overseas portion of the deployment.

B. MCMEX Blue Harrier 97-Avenger was the only U.S. MCM to successfully sweep a practice mine during the exercise (the mine registered the sweeping by releasing a flare). In addition, Avenger helped "prove the concept" of surface MCM support provided from USS Inchon (Avenger and USS Black Hawk stayed underway for the duration of the exercise-the only surface MCM units participating in Blue Harrier to do so).

C. MCMEX Palmeria 97-Avenger was able to find and run a simulated AN/SLQ-48 neutralization run on what the Italians considered an "unfindable" mine.

D. MCMEX Alcudra 97-Avenger performed admirably throughout the exercise and recovered more mines than any other U.S. asset.

3. Change of Commands:

A. LCDR Gary Gilleon, USN relieved LCDR David Fillion, USN at sea on 15 May, 1997.

B. LCDR Stephen Shoen, USN relieved LCDR Gary Gilleon, USN at sea on 17 September, 1997.

4. Change of Executive Officer: LCDR Kurt Hedberg, USNR-TAR arrived on 20 May, 1997 to assume duties as Executive Officer.
